Suggested Itinerary

Day 1

Our overnight will be in Fredericton, NB. Enjoy a leisurely ride with comfort stops and a lunch stop. Overnight at the Lord Beaverbrook. Enjoy this ideal location in the heart of Fredericton's downtown and steps away from the Riverfront Trail, perfect for a leisurely walk after dinner on your own.

Day 2- B, L, D

After our included breakfast we depart for Shediac Cruises. Here it's all about the lobster! Then it's a short drive to picturesque Prince Edward Island. This afternoon we'll cross the 8-mile Confederation Bridge. Here we'll learn of the Acadian Culture with an authentic dinner before we stomp our feet and learn how to play Acadian music with spoons. 3 nights' accommodation at the historic Holman Grand in downtown Charlottetown.

Day 3- B, L

Enjoy breakfast before we depart for the west coast. Visits will include the Potato Museum, an Oyster farm, and a local farm to learn about their goats and other 4-legged friends. This afternoon we'll stretch our legs with a costumed guide who will walk us around the downtown area of Charlottetown and explain to us how Canada gained its independence right here. Browse downtown for some delicious fresh seafood on your own. Later we gather and enjoy a performance of the longest running seasonal play in North America, Anne of Green Gables.

Day 4- B, D

Once breakfast is through, we will depart for Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place. Walk the trails, learn about the author and see why this has been a favorite for well over 100 years. You'll also have the opportunity to walk on the red sand beach of Cavendish. Tonight, enjoy an included lobster supper (substitute for lobster available).

Day 5- B, D

This morning we depart the island and travel back to New Brunswick and the Bay of Fundy. Here is home to the world's largest tides! At Hopewell Rocks you'll see where this happens. This afternoon we'll arrive in Canada's oldest incorporated city, Saint John, NB for a one-night stay at our downtown hotel. Entertainment tonight and included dinner.

Day 6- B, D

Enjoy breakfast before a guided tour of historic St. John and it's reversing falls with an expert guide. This afternoon we'll take the scenic road along the Fundy Trail towards our overnight stay at the 5-star Algonquin Resort in St. Andrews.

Day 7- L

After our included breakfast this morning we'll visit Campobello Island. Enjoy a guided tour of the Roosevelt Cottage before we have a boxed lunch, followed by tea and cookies with Eleanor. An early evening arrival home is expected.
