Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 Thursday April 4 - A leisurely ride to Virginia. Comfort and a lunch stop will be made along the way.

Day 2 Friday April 5 (B, D) - We will be at our furthest point south today, Savannah, GA. Tonight's included dinner will be at The Pirates' House. 2 nights' accommodation in a downtown hotel in the historic district of Savannah.

Day 3 Saturday April 6 (B, D) - Our day will start off with a fun and interesting trolley ride through historic Savannah. You will have hop on/hop off privileges for the remainder of the day to continue exploring at your pace. Dinner tonight will be on a paddle boat for an evening cruise on the Savannah River.

Day 4 Sunday April 7 (B) - We depart for beautiful Beaufort, SC. Enjoy lunch on your own in the downtown area before we regroup for a memorable horse-drawn carriage tour of the historic district. Tonight, we check into our accommodation for 2 nights' in historic Charleston, SC.

Day 5 Monday April 8 (B, D) - This morning we are joined by a local step-on guide for a tour of Charleston which will include The Battery & Citadel. This afternoon, you're in for a treat as we visit Magnolia Plantation & Gardens. Included with your admission will be a guided train tour, guided house tour, "from slavery to freedom" tour, & time for a self-guided tour of the gardens.



Day 6 Tuesday April 9 (B, D) - Today our first stop will be at Brookgreen Gardens. This beautiful oasis is the former home of Anna Hyatt Huntington and her husband. This former rice plantation has been transformed into flower gardens and sculpture gardens. While you're here, enjoy the Lowcountry Center & Native Wildlife Zoo. Tonight, get ready to move and groove as we enjoy a Motown tribute show. Overnight stay in Myrtle Beach, SC.

Day 7 Wednesday April 10 (B, D) - Our tour continues to North Carolina. Visit the Wright Brothers Memorial and see where the 'first flight' took place. We will have a local expert guide with us for our duration on the Outer Banks. 2 nights' accommodations oceanside in Kitty Hawk, NC.

Day 8 Thursday April 11 (B, L, D) - Today, with our local guide, we'll go on an excursion to see the wild ponies of the Outer Banks and visit Cape Hatteras.



Day 9 Friday April 12 (B, D) - We depart for Dover, DE. Here we'll visit the Air Mobility Command Museum. This museum houses over 30 aircrafts varying in roles and sizes with exhibits telling the story of humanitarian, airlift and air refueling history. Overnight Dover, DE.
