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# Suggested Itinerary



## Day 1 - February 15<sup>th</sup>

Depart N. Londonderry for our motorcoach transportation to Boston Logan Airport for our overnight flight to Spain.

## Day 2 - February 16<sup>th</sup> (L)

¡Bienvenidos a España! Upon arrival in Madrid, meet your guide and travel to Toledo, the historic "City of Three Cultures" overlooking the Tagus River. Enjoy a traditional Castilian lunch before exploring its medieval streets, magnificent Gothic Cathedral, and the Sinagoga del Tránsito, home to the Sephardic Museum. You'll also sample Toledo's famous marzipan before continuing to Madrid for an overnight stay.

## Day 3 - February 17<sup>th</sup> (B, D)

After breakfast, explore Madrid's historic center, including Plaza Mayor, the Habsburg Quarter, and Mercado de San Miguel. Enjoy free time for lunch before an afternoon visit to the renowned Prado Museum, home to masterpieces by Velázquez, Goya, and El Greco. This evening, celebrate the start of the journey with a welcome dinner in one of Madrid's atmospheric cave cellars.

## Day 4 - February 18<sup>th</sup> (B)

This morning, board the high-speed AVE train to Seville, arriving in just over two and a half hours. Upon arrival, visit the stunning Plaza de España before checking in. The rest of the afternoon is free to explore and enjoy the charm of Seville at your own pace.

## Day 5 - February 19<sup>th</sup> (B)

Today, explore Seville's highlights, beginning with the Palacio de las Dueñas, known for its art-filled rooms and beautiful courtyards. Later, visit the impressive Seville Cathedral and the iconic Giralda Tower, the resting place of Christopher Columbus. The evening is free to enjoy Seville's vibrant tapas bars and lively streets.



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Day 6 - February 20<sup>th</sup> (B, L, D)

Depart Seville and travel east toward the Mediterranean, stopping in the unique cliffside village of Setenil de las Bodegas and the dramatic town of Ronda, perched above the El Tajo gorge. After time for exploration and lunch, continue to the Costa Tropical and arrive in Almuñécar, your home for the next nine nights.

Day 7 - February 21<sup>st</sup> (B, D)

Discover Almuñécar on a guided walk through its rich history, from ancient Phoenician and Roman sites to the charming Old Quarter. Along the way, enjoy local tapas and regional specialties before ending with beautiful seaside views at Peñón del Cristo.

Day 8 - February 22<sup>nd</sup> (B, D)

Travel to Granada to visit the magnificent Alhambra, Spain's most visited monument, and explore its stunning palaces and fortifications. Later, enjoy a wine tasting at an award-winning winery before returning to Almuñécar for a free evening.

Day 9 - February 23<sup>rd</sup> (B, L, D)

Today, discover the Costa Tropical's sugarcane heritage with a visit and tasting at a traditional rum distillery. Then relax at scenic Cabria Beach, where you'll enjoy lunch in a beautiful garden setting and free time to swim or unwind by the Mediterranean.

Day 10 - February 24<sup>th</sup> (B, D)

Return to Granada to explore the Albayzín, the city's historic Moorish quarter, with its winding streets, whitewashed homes, and beautiful views of the Alhambra and Sierra Nevada. Enjoy time to browse local markets, relax in a traditional tea house, and soak up the area's unique Andalusian-Arabic atmosphere before returning to the coast.

Day 11 - February 25<sup>th</sup> (B, D)

Visit a traditional olive mill to learn about Andalucía's olive oil heritage and enjoy a tasting of its renowned "liquid gold." Afterwards, explore the picturesque village of Nigüelas, nestled in the foothills of the Sierra Nevada.

Day 12 - February 26<sup>th</sup> (B, D)

Travel into the scenic Alpujarra Valley, visiting Capileira, Spain's highest village, and the picturesque whitewashed villages of the Poqueira Gorge. Enjoy tastings of local ham, wine, and cheese, visit a traditional weaving workshop, and browse for local crafts before returning to Almuñécar. This evening, experience a live flamenco performance paired with dinner.

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Day 13 - February 27<sup>th</sup> (B, L, D)

Travel to Guadix, known for its unique cave-dwelling quarter, where many residents still live in homes carved into the hillsides. Enjoy a traditional bread-making experience in a cave home and sample the freshly baked results before returning to Almuñécar in the evening.

Day 14 - February 28<sup>th</sup> (B, D)

For your final excursion, visit the spectacular Nerja Caves, home to some of the world's largest stalactites. Then explore the charming hilltop town of Frigiliana, known for its rich multicultural heritage and local Moscatel wine. Return along one of the Mediterranean's most scenic coastal drives before gathering for a farewell dinner with wine.

Day 15 - March 1<sup>st</sup> (B)

It's time to say goodbye to the Almuñécar and our beautiful Mediterranean coastline. Our transfer will bring you back to the US. This is an early morning departure for the airport.
