Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 - Saturday November 16th Enjoy a leisurely ride to Virginia for our overnight stay.

Day 4 – Tuesday November 19th (B, L, D) Get ready for a fun filled day as we are joined by a local step-on-guide who will drive by some homes of the stars, see the Capitol, Music Row, The Ryman, The Parthenon and so much more!
