## **ITINERARY**

- **Day 1** (D) Fly to Denver, CO. where we will board a luxury motorcoach and travel to our overnight accommodations. Denver
- **Day 2** (B,L,D) This morning we'll start our touring at the Garden of the Gods. We'll take a scenic ride and explore a bit to learn more about this beautiful spot. Then it's off to the US Airforce Academy for a guided tour. Dinner tonight will be at the Flying W Ranch. Colorado Springs.
- **Day 3** (B,L,D) Get ready to go above the clouds. Our first train will be here at Pikes Peak Cog Railway. You'll not soon forget this 3.5-hour roundtrip excursion. Since 1891 adventurous travelers have been climbing to the top on this railway. Colorado Springs
- **Day 4** (B,L,D) Today we will board the Royal Gorge Route Railroad. This 12-mile route follows the most famous portion of the old Denver and Rio Grande Western train line. We ride through the "Grand Canyon of The Arkansas" on an unforgettable journey over the famous Hanging Bridge, which clings precariously to the steep granite walls of Royal Gorge. Alamosa
- **Day 5** (B,L) The Cumbres & Toltec Scenic RR will take us over the original Rio Grande Line today over the Rockies. This is America's most spectacular narrow gauge steam railroad, and it explores 50 miles of wild and rugged territory between Antonito and Cumbres Pass, the highest point on the railroad. Imagine along the way the many gold miners and loggers who traveled the same route long ago. Durango
- **Day 6** (B,L,D) Visit Mesa Verde National Park to see the well-preserved cliff dwellings of the Pueblo Indians, dating back to 1200 A.D. Experience magnificent canyon views at a picnic amidst a grove of Utah juniper. This evening we attend the Bar D Chuckwagon dinner and show for a taste of the old west! Durango



Day 7 (B) It's "full steam ahead" again today as we board Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad. Voted one of the "Top Ten Most Exciting Train Journeys in the World" by the Society of American Travel Writers, this route winds through the spectacular and breathtaking canyons in the remote wilderness of the two-millionacre San Juan National Forest. The locomotives used today remain 100% coal-fired, steam-operated and are maintained in their original condition. We'll make an extended stop in Silverton for lunch on your own and shopping. 1 night in Grand Junction

Day 8 (B,D) This morning we board Amtrak's California Zephyr for our last journey by train. Experienced travelers say it's the most beautiful train trip in all North America... and as you climb to the sky through the heart of the Rocky Mountains, you'll find it hard to disagree. For you railfans, we also journey through the historic Moffat Tunnel! This tunnel is 6.2 miles long and takes approximately 15 minutes to go through. It is at this point that the train crosses the Continental Divide and is at an elevation of over 9000 feet! Denver

Day 9 (B) Depending on our departure time, we may have time to explore Denver

before flying home.
