Suggested Itinerary



Thursday April 16th – (D) Enjoy a relaxing ride to our overnight stay in Annapolis, MD. Comfort stops and a lunch stop (on own) will be made. Tonight, enjoy your included dinner at a local restaurant.

Friday April 17th – (B,L,D) This morning we will be joined by an expert guide for a tour of the United States Naval Academy. Walk the grounds and hear what it's like and what is expected of you at one of our Nations most prestigious schools. Enjoy an included lunch prior to taking a cruise and learning more from the water's view. We then continue south to Virginia. In our travels we will go in and on the famous Chesapeake Bay Bridge-Tunnel. Tonight, dinner is included at a local restaurant. 3 Nights stay Virginia Beach.

Saturday April 18th – (B,D) The day begins with time on your own at the beach. Enjoy the beautiful boardwalk with its many shops and eating establishments. This afternoon we'll visit the Virginia Aquarium. Here, look for sea turtles, octopus, endless fish, and experience fun touch tanks. Our day will continue at the Military Aviation Museum, home to one of the world's largest collections of flying vintage military aircraft. Dinner and entertainment is here tonight!

Sunday April 19th – (B,L) Start the day with a front row seat as we cruise around the Navy Yard on the Victory Rover. Check out the destroyers, submarines, and other vessels. Attend the "Hullabaloo" prior to the show. Enjoy food, drink and music. The Virginia International Tattoo, is a musical spectacle that is part parade, part theatre and sometimes, part circus. Monday April 20th – (B,L,D) We say goodbye to Virginia Beach as we travel to the National Museum of the Marine Corps. Through immersive exhibits, dramatic storytelling, and iconic aircraft and vehicles, you'll experience the courage and sacrifice of Marines from 1775 to today. The National Museum of the United States Army honors over 250 years of history. See the Army's role in shaping our nation. Watch a moving tribute to the soldiers who have served in every major conflict in American history.
