SUGGESTED ITINERARY

Day 1 June 22 - D

Depart from N. Londonderry for transportation to Boston. Fly to North Dakota and overnight for 2 nights in Medora. Upon arrival meet Teddy and hear of his time spent in this beautiful area, and the national park now named after him.

Day 2 June 23 - B,D

Today discover the wild beauty of Theodore Roosevelt National Park, where roaming bison, wild horses and dramatic badlands landscapes showcase nature at it's finest. Tonight enjoy a unique Western dining experience at the Pitchfork Fondue, followed by an evening under the stars at the Medora Musical – an energetic blend of music, dancing and cowboy spirit.

Day 3 June 24 - B,D

Today we travel to South Dakota. Enjoy the western town of Deadwood where Wild Bill played his last hand. Then it's off to Mt. Rushmore to see this carving masterpiece up close. Our day will end at the Crazy Horse Memorial, see the worlds largest mountain carving. This Lakota War leader was an important figure in the fight to keep his Peoples' land from the government.

Day 4 June 25 - B,L,D

Our visit to Wall drug will be interesting to all. Enjoy America's largest private collection of western art as you browse the many buildings. After a delicious lunch we'll visit the Badland's National Park. These striking geologic deposits contain one of the world's richest fossil beds. Tonight be entertained by singing cowboys as we travel by wagon through Custer State Park where the Buffalo roam, to our dinner under the stars.

Day 5 June 26 - B,D

The day will bring us to amazing views as we travel over the Big Horn Mountain range into Cody, WY. See wildlife and keep on the lookout for free roaming herds of sheep and cattle.

Day 6 June 27 - B,D

This morning you're in for a treat as we visit the Buffalo Bill Center of the West. Five unforgettable museums – From Native culture and cowboy legends to Western art, natural history, and one of the largest firearms collections around. You are sure to find some interesting artifacts here. Tonight get ready for a good time at the Cody Cattle Company dinner show followed by the Cody Rodeo.

Day 7 June 28 - B,L,D

Enjoy our ride through our Nation's first national park. Yellowstone offers endless opportunities for wildlife viewing, and geological activities with springs and geysers. Tonight overnight in Livingston, MT.

Day 8 June 29 - B,L,D

This morning we'll visit the Museum of the Rockies. This museum has a vast collection of dinosaur fossils, along with exhibits of regional & native history. Tonight enjoy a peaceful night in the valley at the foot of the Mission Mountains. Relax with a beautiful sunset and views worthy of a painting.

Day 9 June 30 - B,D

Flathead Lake, the largest natural freshwater lake by surface area in the western United States, boasts a rich history tied to its formation, indigenous peoples, steamboat era, and ongoing ecological research. Learn more about this beautiful lake as we take a scenic cruise. Tonight we visit Montana Horse Works. This working horse ranch will give you knowledge of these majestic creatures. Dinner will be under the big sky of Montana.

Day 10 July 1 - B,L

Get ready for a day of fun as we climb into an antique Red Bus and travel with our guide across the 'Road to the Sun' in Glacier National Park. Our travels will bring us over the Continental Divide, by mountain meadows, and views of glaciers. Our coach will pick us up on the other side and continue across the border into Canada for the next 3 nights in Calgary.

Day 11 July 2 - B,D

Joined by a local guide we'll travel to Banff National Park and to the beautiful Lake Louise. Discover the jewel of the Canadian Rockies.

Day 12 July 3 - B

It's Stampede day! We'll have a full day of Rodeo events including bull riding, barrel racing, bareback relay and chuckwagon racing. This is a world class event that draws crowds from all corners of the world.

Day 13 July 4 - B

We say goodbye to the beautiful Rocky Mountains and head home today. Depending on flight time, a morning activity may be added.


