- Winning artists must provide original artwork to Elections office

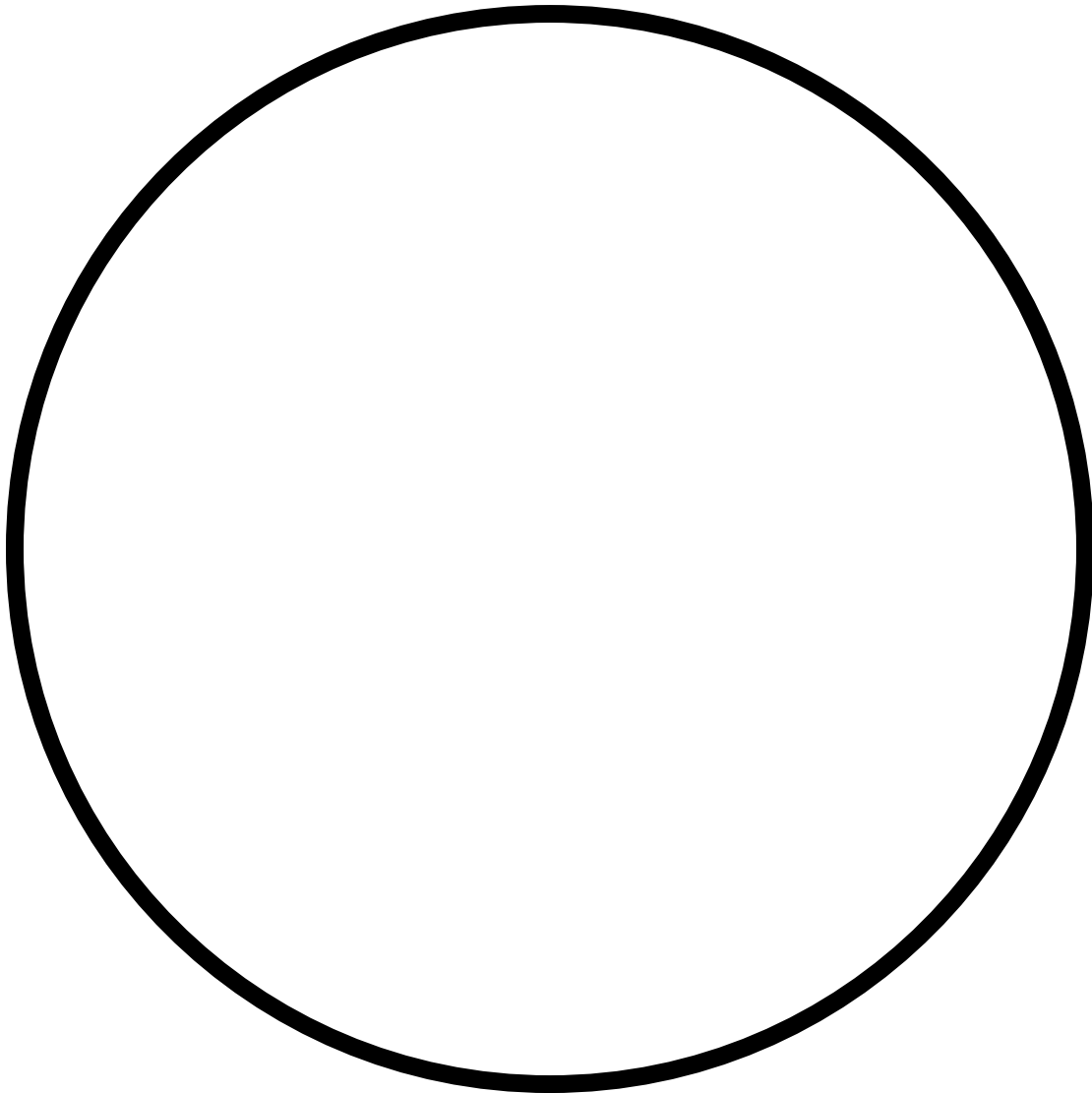
