Our church has served as a Christian anchor to historic Gloucester Courthouse for more than 140 years. Gloucester is located in coastal Virginia along the southernmost portion of the Chesapeake Bay. We are a community that is surrounded by water, and it has shaped our history, our environment, and our lives.

In 2016, after considerable prayer and discernment, the congregation of First Presbyterian Church voted overwhelmingly to join ECO, a Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians, so we are now Grace Covenant Presbyterian Church. One of our key values is that the Bible Guides Us. Grace on Main has Christian Education classes for all ages. Our Raising Grace Ministry serves nursery, preschool, and elementary children. It includes Sunday School, Children's Church, daytime Bible School, and special events such as an Easter Egg Hunt. Middle and High schoolers participate in our Youth on Main Ministry including Bible study, fellowship, missions, and special events. Mid-Week Hurried Family Dinner is followed by Bible Study.


The compensation and benefit package will be competitive with similar ECO positions and commensurate with experience.

With a courthouse square dating back to the late 1600s, a statue commemorating the legacy of Pocahontas, and a historic inn once owned by George Washington's grandparents, Gloucester boasts many areas of historical importance. Gloucester Point served as a pivotal site in the Revolutionary War and was the location of the Battle of the Hook, an event ultimately leading to the British surrender. Gloucester is also the former homeplace of Dr. Walter Reed, Thomas Calhoun Walker, and Pocahontas! Gloucester is just across the river from Yorktown, Williamsburg, and Jamestown, known as the area's Historic Triangle.





In addition to its rich history, Gloucester offers many opportunities to enjoy the outdoors. Located on Virginia's beautiful Middle Peninsula, Gloucester is home to watermen and water enthusiasts. With five rivers surrounding the county, there is no shortage of boating, fishing, crabbing, and the like. Gloucester is also home to several beautiful parks, including Virginia's newest state park: Machicomico. Gloucester's parks are perfect for any lover of the outdoors, containing miles of well-maintained hiking trails, small craft launch ramps/rentals, beaches, campsites, lodging, and areas to picnic or play.





Community warmth abounds in Gloucester. The award-winning Main Street includes beautiful sculptures, murals, and art galleries; and is the site of several festivals, including the Plein Air Festival and the Daffodil Festival. The Plein Air festival lasts a month in early summer and provides residents with opportunities to meet and interact with artists from around the nation. The Daffodil Festival, held the first weekend of April each year, celebrates the heritage of the daffodil and the community. People come from all over to enjoy the parade, hear live music, see the crowning of the Daffodil Queen, and visit the spectacular blooms and arrangements on display at the Daffodil Show. Also on Main Street are charming options for dining, retail, and business. Many of the restaurants carry fresh local seafood, the shops are full of unique gifts and clothing, and the street itself is perfect for an afternoon stroll. Though Gloucester is a wonderful place to live, play, and work, some of its residents travel to neighboring localities for employment. Gloucester's central location and smooth traffic flow allow for an easy commute to Hampton Roads, the Northern Neck, the Historic Triangle, and even Richmond. The unique charm and history of Gloucester make it a marvelous place to call home.
