Annual Rally Planning Meeting

The team discussed plans for this year's rally, including pricing (\$50 for weekend pass, \$20 for day pass, \$25 for optional dinner) and venue arrangements at \$900 with a deposit already paid.

Bill reported on the first committee meeting where new members were appointed, including Daksh as secretary and Eliesha handling catering again.

The team plans to improve the ticketing process through Humantix website by collecting more information upfront and implementing barcode scanning, while also promoting pre-event ticket sales rather than selling at the door.

The next committee meeting is scheduled for May 24th to discuss the itinerary and improve the checkout process. A question was raised about Saturday night entertainment, noting feedback about the lack of a traditional AA meeting that night.

Bill agreed to forward this feedback and suggested the possibility of having parallel meetings in future, including better utilization of secondary rooms.

As it is the Committee's policy for each sub-committee to have a Committee Member as a link between the main Committee and the Sub-committee, and Rusty is not able to do so this year, Bill was asked to raise this at the next Rally Sub-committee meeting. Also, there was a reminder to have the meeting minutes be submitted in advance, and any requests of the Management Committee to be highlighted for the Secretary to place in the Committee Agenda.
