## Episcopal Church of the Nativity Vestry Meeting Minutes June 17, 2025 Joffrion Library

### I. Attendance

II. Tommy Lotz offered a devotional. Father Michael Goldsmith called the meeting to order.

#### III. Minutes

Note: There was not a vestry meeting in May due to weather and therefore, at this meeting the vestry is approving the April minutes. No additions or changes to the April vestry meeting minutes. Erin Elliott made a motion to accept the April vestry minutes, Minda Alexander seconded. **Motion carried.** 

## IV. Ministry Reports

Father Michael asked the Vestry to review the ministry reports included in their packet and asked for any additional ministry reports. No additional reports at this time.

### V. Treasurer's Report

Gary Anglin reviewed the May financials noting that financials appear to be on track for the year. He explained that we have only paid half of the Orkin bill and plan to pay the remaining amount once the work is complete. Gary stated that once we get the final numbers on the construction project, we will create a cash flow projection to see how much we will need to borrow and then start the process of getting a line of credit. He expects that we have enough cash in the bank to get us to the end of the year before needing to borrow money.

The vestry discussed the next steps for signing a contract with Fite once we have the construction numbers. Carter wells made a motion that once the contract from Fite has been received, Charles Ray (legal) and Gary Anglin (treasurer) will review it and if they recommend signing it, and if the price is below \$4.5 million, the vestry authorizes Carter Wells to sign the contract with Fite. Minda Alexander seconded. **Motion carried.** 

## VI. Senior Warden Report

Carter Wells thanked the Finance Committee for taking the time to discuss financial issues in depth and reminded the vestry that all the recommendations that come from the Finance Committee are discussed in detail before coming to vestry.

## VII. Junior Warden Report

Minda Alexander reported that there will be a building & grounds workday on June 28<sup>th</sup> and encouraged the vestry to attend and help with several projects around the church. Lunch will be provided.

## VIII. Clergy Reports

Deacon Bob discussed the idea of asking the bishop for an additional deacon for Nativity as the parish grows.

Mother Melissa gave a report on Easter, since the vestry has not met since then. She stated that for Easter weekend, we had over 1,000 people at the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday services. The following week, we had John Gatta as a speaker for Creation Care Sunday and we also celebrated Senior Sunday with sermons from several of our seniors. On Pentecost, we had 9 baptisms. We have started our summer service at the 8:45am service with cursillo music which has been well attended.

Mother Rosie reported that she is working on the Women's Retreat in September. New member/new comer pancake breakfast is coming up and Mother Rosie encouraged the vestry to attend. Pride parade is the same Sunday at 11am and Nativity will have a table but the welcome center will not be open due to the parade route. Mother Rosie encouraged the vestry to attend the upcoming Listening Session at Nativity for the election of a new bishop. Also, the Women's Build with Habitat for Humanity is still happening two days a month through August. Mother Rosie discussed a person from Nativity who is considering ordination and asked the vestry to sign an approval letter for this person to continue the discernment process.

Father Michael reported that the new hearing assist programs are now up and running in both the Nave and Bibb Chapel and are working great. Father Michael reminded the vestry about several upcoming events. NativityFest is coming up on

August 24<sup>th</sup>. Historically, the vestry has helped to host NativityFest and Kayela Allen will be reaching out about ways to help with this event. Nativity Parish Retreat at Camp McDowell will be Nov. 14-16<sup>th</sup>. This coming Sunday is the Ground Breaking Ceremony for the Becoming One Body Campaign and VBS kickoff. Father Michael asked the vestry to attend and wear their vestry nametags.

Father Michael thanked Patrick Robbins for serving as chair of the Stewardship Committee for the last several years. He is now stepping down as chair and Father Michael asked the vestry to share any ideas of new people to serve on this committee. He also explained that the Finance Committee is considering when best to have stewardship in the calendar year.

Carter Wells brought up 333 Franklin St. to discuss options for what to do with this building once The Vine moves out. The vestry discussed the previous report provided on that building which recommended three options which included selling it, renovating it for use (which would involve gutting it to create a space that is accessible), or tear it down and rent parking spaces for income.

After a prayer, the meeting was adjourned.
