Participants in Antioch Adventure and Camp Sunshine swim at the pool every day from 10:00am-11:30am. Each camper is tested to determine their skill level and what areas of the pool they can swim while at camp. Swim tests are offered before camps start and on every campers first day.

CHILDCARE EXPENSE STATEMENTS

Each time a payment is made, a receipt is generated. It is your responsibility to maintain all receipts for Flexible Spending Reports and Income Tax purposes. A \$5 administrative fee will apply for anyone requesting a new statement. Statements will be available for pick up in the Parks Office within 48 hours of the request.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Camper Information Form must be completed for each child registering for camp. If your child has special needs such as allergies, phobias, or medical alerts such as asthma or epilepsy, please make sure this information is included. This form can be found online at www.antioch.il.gov. This form must be turned in at the time of registration.

If your child will require medication while attending camp, a doctor's note stating the need for medicine must be submitted prior to the start of camp. A parent/guardian must also complete and sign a Medication Consent Form.

Make your splash this summer by becoming a season pass holder at the Aqua Center! Purchase your Aqua Center Season Pass before April 30 to receive a \$5.00 discount. Season Pass Holders receive early entry into the pool Monday-Friday before general admission patrons. A family is defined as parent/quardians and their children living in the same household. Proof of residency is required as well as birth certificates of children. Passes are nonrefundable and non-transferable. Paid admission cannot be used as credit towards a season pass. A fee of \$10 is charged to replace lost or stolen passes.

GENERAL POOL INFORMATION

A child not toilet-trained MUST wear a swim diaper that is covered by a plastic swim liner. Plastic liner must have a tight fitting plastic or rubber part that is fitted around the legs and waist. Aqua diapers are reusable and should be worn over a swim diaper. Children without appropriate diapers are not allowed in the pool.

All Visitors must wear proper swim attire for safety and health concerns while using the pool. Clothing made from material such as cotton is strictly prohibited.

US Coast Guard approved lifejackets are allowed in the pool. **No other flotation devices are allowed**. This includes water wings, noodles, inner tubes, un-approved lifejackets, etc.

***The Aqua Center has a limited number of approved lifejackets available for use free of charge with a secured ID.

Lifeguards are responsible for enforcing safety rules and responding to emergencies. All non-swimmers should remain within an arm's length of a responsible adult at all times.

Children age 11 and younger are not permitted in the facility unless accompanied by an individual over 16 years of age.

Lounge and deck chairs are for ages 16 years and older.

Coolers and food are not allowed into the facility.

No glass containers or controlled substances are allowed. This includes baby food in glass containers.

Safety breaks will be announced at designated times. Adults and infants, who cannot walk on their own, will be allowed in the water during safety breaks. Children must be held at all times. Slides are only open to adults during safety breaks.

No smoking inside the facility or within 15 feet of entrance. Please dispose of cigarette butts in the proper containers on-site.

No gum allowed in the facility.

Additional facility rules are posted at the Aqua Center.

ANTIOCH WAVES SWIM TEAM

All swimmers must be able to swim, any stroke, one length of the pool (25 meters). Swim team practices will spotlight continued development of all four strokes (freestyle, back, breast and butterfly) as well as diving and turns. There will be a focus on technique and endurance. All swimmers are eligible to compete in up to five swim meets during the season. Rental Reservation

All rental reservations must be made at least 2 weeks in advance before selected rental date. A refundable security deposit is required when making a reservation. Rental Base Fee must be paid at least two weeks prior to event. Individual guests must check in at the Aqua Center's admission counter on the day of the rental. Rental Refund Policy

A \$25 cancellation fee will be charged for all cancelled reservations. If the cancellation is made within 2 weeks of the reserved date, a \$50 fee will be charged. Should the Aqua Center close due to inclement weather, another rental date can be requested or a full refund will be given.

SWIM LESSON LEVELS

PRESCHOOL - Ages 3-5 years

The class is a water acclimation class in which children learn to separate from their parents, blow bubbles, and become comfortable in the water.

LEVEL 1- Ages 4 and up

This class is for children who have already mastered the skills learned in preschool and are ready to progress to underwater exploration, floating, kicking, and forward movement in the water.

LEVEL 2- Ages 5 and up

Level 2 is for children who already can float on their front and back, understand movement in the water using various methods and are ready to begin rhythmic breathing.

LEVEL 3- Ages 6 and up

In this class, your child will perfect the front and back crawl. They will also learn the elementary backstroke, whip kick, and dolphin kicks along with treading.

LEVEL 4- Ages 6 and up

The concentration in this level will be on refinement of the above strokes, learning the butterfly, breast stroke and sidestroke, along with dives and turns.

LEVEL 5- Ages 6 and up

Level 5 refines all strokes, works on endurance building, surface dives and lifesaving skills.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Swim lessons WILL be held if it is raining or cold. Classes will only be canceled for lightning, tornado warnings or severe weather. Please call the Aquatic Center at 847-395 POOL for updates.

If lessons are canceled by us due to weather, we will hold makeup lessons the following Friday at the same time.

Classes with low enrollment may be combined or canceled. If your child's class is canceled, you will receive a full refund.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds for Swim Lessons are issued according to the following guidelines:

- 100% refund if canceled more than two weeks before start of sessions.
- 50% refund if canceled less than two weeks before start of session.
- No refunds will be issued after you session has started. Scheduled classes that are missed cannot be made up at another time and will not receive a refund.






