

### Form of Government





The Village of Antioch, a non-home rule municipality, is governed by a Mayor and six member Board of Trustees, all of whom are elected for four-year staggered terms. The Board is the legislative body of the Village government.



Village Board meetings are held at 6:30 p.m. on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month. All meetings are open to the public and are located at the Village Hall, 935 Skidmore Drive.
