


There they crucified him, and with him two others—one on each side and Jesus in the middle. – John 19:18

We are now deep in the Easter season, a time when our thoughts naturally turn to the crucifixion of Jesus. I once read where an author pointed out something profound: God often deepens our understanding of Jesus' crucifixion by inviting us into moments of self-giving love. In other words, we come to comprehend the cross more fully through two essential steps.

First, we must intentionally say “yes” to the opportunities God places before us to practice self-giving love.

Second, we must pause afterward to reflect on how those moments point us toward the even greater self-giving love God has shown us in Christ.



Every day, God presents us with such opportunities, often in ordinary, everyday ways. It might be the weary teacher who longs to head home at the end of a long day, yet chooses to stay and offer extra help to a struggling student. Or the exhausted spouse who craves nothing more than quiet rest, but sets that aside to listen attentively when their partner needs to talk. These small, daily invitations to give of ourselves are God's gentle way of drawing us closer to the heart of the cross. When we respond with a willing “yes,” our hearts become more open to understanding what Jesus did for us. But saying yes is only the beginning. We also need to reflect. Awhile back, I had my evening carefully planned—something I was really looking forward to. Then an opportunity arose to set those plans aside and help someone in need. I noticed how difficult it felt to let go of my own desires, even for just a few hours. Then my mind turned to Jesus, who gave up far more—He gave up His very life.

My prayer this Easter season is that each of us would say yes to these invitations, reflect on their deeper meaning, and in doing so, grow in our awe and appreciation of Jesus' crucifixion—the ultimate act of self-giving love poured out for us. May it move us not just to understand the cross, but to live in grateful response to it.


All parents are welcome. This group meets during the same time as Cove Spring Kids.
