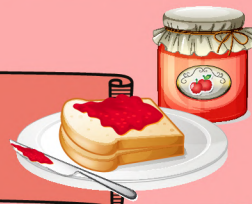


Sensorial Play: Spice Up Your Senses

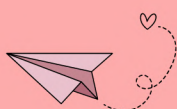

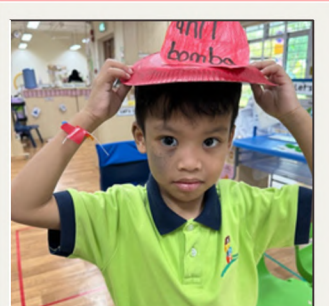

The KI children presented a remarkable performance for their mothers, where they expressed their love and appreciation for them.

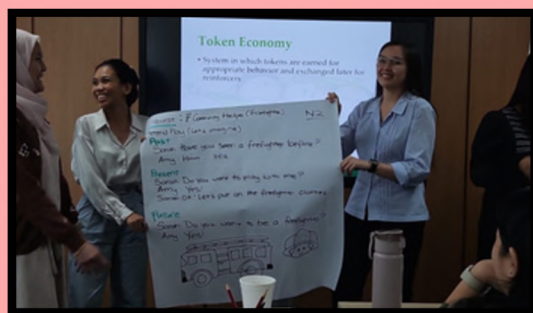


Teachers' Training



Our teachers engaged in a valuable training session on supporting children with special needs in starting conversations and building social skills. Through practical strategies, role-playing, and real-life scenarios, they explored ways to create inclusive, encouraging environments where every child can connect and communicate with confidence!

The teachers learnt a wide range of strategies that can be used to help children with diverse needs so as to cope with their challenging behaviour in school. Strategies taught include changing the classroom climate, the use of behavioural contracts, self-monitoring, 'Stop, Think, Do', and peer sensitivity training.



The teachers explored the diverse needs of young learners in a thoughtful training session. They dove into topics like temperaments, learning styles, sensory preferences, and emotional development. They also had an opportunity to equip themselves with tools to better understand and support every child's unique journey.



Healthy Recipe: Fruity Froyo

Ingredients:

- 1) 2 to 3 fruits of your choice
- 2) 100 - 200ml plain yoghurt



Directions:

- 1) Wash the fruits thoroughly.
- 2) Cut the fruits into smaller pieces.
- 3) Layer the bottom of your serving cup with the fruit pieces before adding on a layer of yoghurt.
- 4) Repeat the process of layering the fruit pieces and yoghurt alternately till all the ingredients are used up!
