Chinese New Year Awareness Day

A special highlight was the parent-child dumpling making activity, where families came together to bond, create and celebrate the festive season!

Our K1 and K2 children also had the opportunity to spread festive cheer to the community through their performance at Safra Jurong as part of our community collaboration with Pioneer Community Centre. This momentous experience made the celebration even more memorable for everyone. It was truly a joyful occasion filled with culture, togetherness, and celebration.



Warisan Budaya & Wenhua Yichan

Our children engaged in Warisan Budaya activities where they were introduced to the history of traditional 'kuih' in Malay culture, and learnt about important moral values, such as respecting their parents and showing kindness to others. Through practical experiences and discussions, the children were able to make connections between cultural practices and their daily lives. They also explored the use of a traditional water vessel known as a 'kendi air', and were introduced to the Jawi script, where they showed curiosity and interest in recognising and tracing the Jawi letters.

For the Wenhua Yichan activities, our children explored the four treasures of study - structure and function of the brush, experimented with different brush strokes, and created their own ink paintings. Using plasticine, they moulded the four treasures, which helped to strengthen their fine motor skills and creativity. The children also explored calligraphy, where they practised holding the brush correctly and developed better hand control. The end result was the creation of exquisite scrolls to showcase their work.

Throughout these activities, our children demonstrated enthusiasm, creativity, and active participation. They were able to express their ideas, ask questions, and engage meaningfully with their peers and teachers. These experiences not only enhanced their cultural awareness but also supported the development of their confidence, communication skills, and appreciation for different traditions.



TOTAL DEFENCE DAY



What an exciting Total Defence Day we had! The children had a wonderful time taking part in fun games such as the firefighter obstacle course and the 'Match Me Relay,' where they worked together to match equipment to the correct occupations. 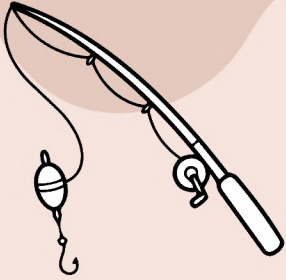
DISPOSITION DAY

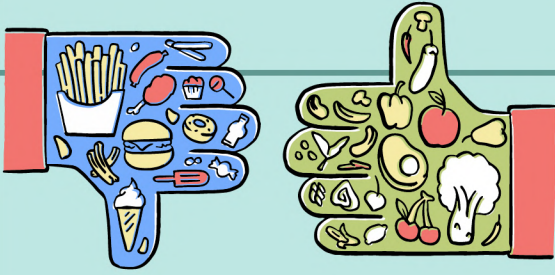

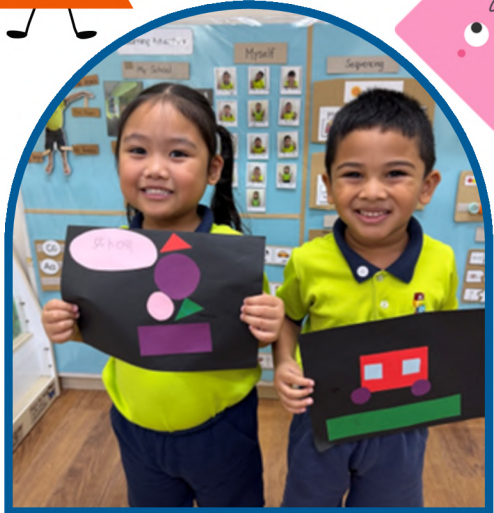
N2B



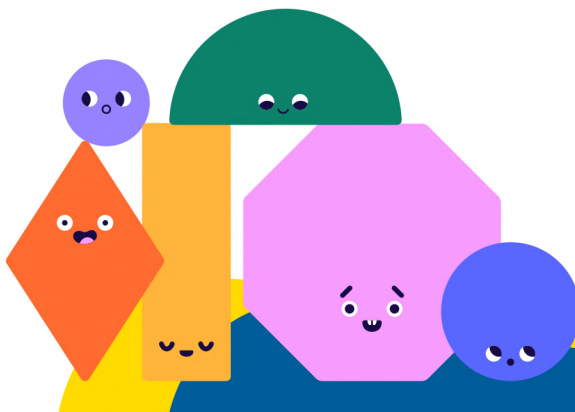
Choo Choo!

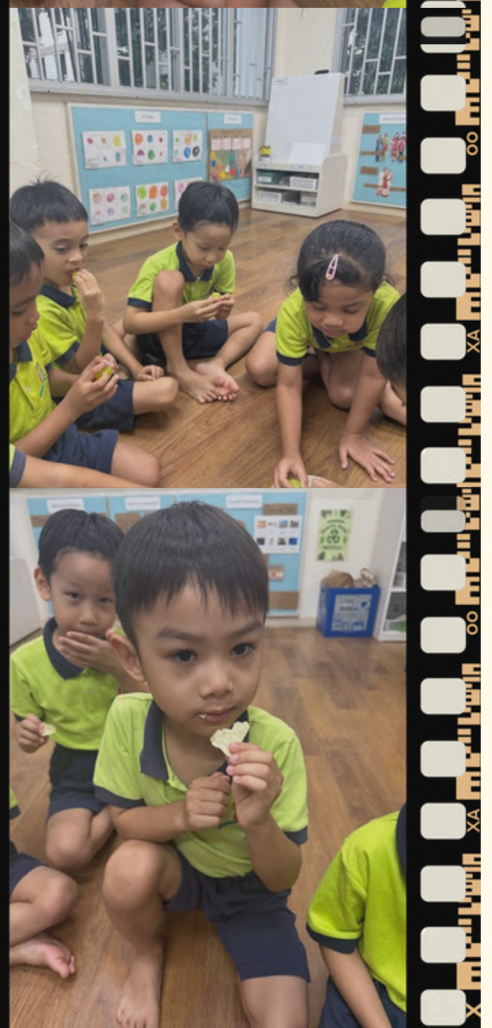




KINDERGARTEN 2

Malay Language



Peringkat Asuhan: Murid-murid telah menghasilkan kraf salasilah keluarga yang merupakan pokok menggunakan cat hijau dan coklat. Tajaka 1: Sempena sambutan Tahun Baru Cina, murid-murid telah menghasilkan kraf sampul duit berbentuk ikan yang kreatif dan menarik. Mereka mengoyakkan dan menampal kertas sampul duit pada lukisan ikan dengan penuh teliti. Mereka kelihatan fokus dan tekun sepanjang aktiviti dijalankan. Aktiviti ini bukan sahaja menyeronokkan, malah dapat meningkatkan kreativiti serta kemahiran motor halus murid-murid.



Tajaka 2: Murid-murid telah mempelajari huruf 'b' melalui pelbagai aktiviti yang menyeronokkan di dalam kelas. Mereka menunjukkan minat yang baik semasa mengenal huruf dan menyebut bunyi huruf tersebut. Selain itu, murid-murid juga telah menggunakan doh untuk membentuk huruf 'b'. Aktiviti ini membantu meningkatkan kemahiran motor halus serta koordinasi tangan dan mata mereka. Secara keseluruhannya, murid-murid dapat mengenali huruf 'b' dengan lebih baik, namun masih memerlukan sedikit bimbingan untuk pengukuhan.



Tadika 1: Murid-murid telah mempelajari bunyi /n/ dan gabungannya (/Na/, /Ni/, /Nu/) dengan vokal a, i, u untuk membentuk perkataan mudah. Di lembaran kerja yang diberikan, mereka mengenal pasti perkataan tersebut, kemudian melingkari dan mewarna perkataan yang dipilih. Aktiviti ini bukan sahaja menyeronokkan, tetapi juga membantu mereka menguatkan kemahiran membaca serta memahami fonik dengan lebih baik!



Tadika 2: Murid-murid telah menghasilkan kraf muka menggunakan kertas pinggan dan barang kraf. Mereka memotong, melekat, dan menghias kraf mereka sambil menyalurkan kreativiti dan mengasah kemahiran motor halus. Aktiviti ini bukan sahaja menyeronokkan, tetapi juga dapat membantu mereka mengekspresikan diri sambil menggunakan semula barang terpakai.

Chinese Language



在学习我的身体的主题活动中，豆豆班的宝贝参加了一个手掌印画活动。在活动过程中，教师引导幼儿观察颜色，并帮助幼儿在手掌上涂上颜料。幼儿安静地看着教师操作，并配合伸出小手。完成手掌印后，幼儿低头认真观察自己的手掌印迹，对作品表现出兴趣和好奇。通过触摸颜料和观察颜色变化，幼儿在活动中进行感官探索，对色彩表现出兴趣。

在‘认识身体’的展示介绍活动中，N2的孩子们积极参与。老师通过展示裁剪好的身体部位图片，引导孩子们选择自己最喜欢的身体部位进行介绍。孩子们勇敢地走到前面分享自己的想法，表现得开心、自信且主动。其他孩子也能安静地聆听同伴的介绍，并用掌声给予鼓励。活动氛围轻松愉快，孩子们在分享与互动中加深了对身体部位的认识。



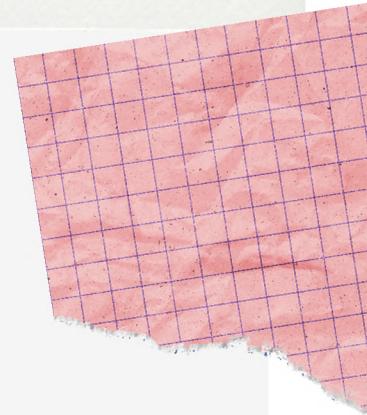

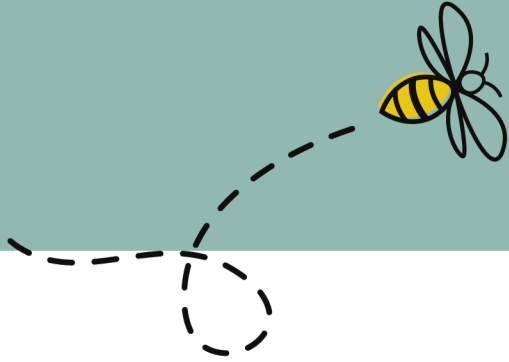
Staff Bonding - Chinese New Year Celebration & Iftar
