





WARISAN BUDAYA



WENHUA YICHAN











In Term 2, our children explored the rich cultural traditions of Warisan Budaya (Malay Heritage) and Wenhua Yichan (Chinese Heritage) through the theme 'The Art of Self-Defence'. In Warisan Budaya, they learned about silat, a traditional Malay martial art. Children explored its origins, practiced basic movements, identified traditional attire and musical elements as well as discovered its cultural significance, including how it is performed at Malay weddings.

During Wenhua Yichan, the children were introduced to Chinese Martial Arts, including movements from Kung Fu. These activities helped develop their balance, coordination and self-confidence, while instilling values like perseverance, calmness and discipline.

Both programmes offered hands-on experiences that went beyond physical movement. The children engaged in meaningful conversations, rhythmic activities and cultural storytelling. These experiences strengthened not only their physical skills but also their appreciation for Asian heritage, helping them grow with pride, awareness, and respect for cultural diversity.



CHINESE LANGUAGE CLASSES



在"食物"主题活动中,老师组织了一次有趣的` 海苔饭团制作体验。活动开始,老师先带领孩 子们认识制作饭团所需的主要食材——米饭 和海苔碎,孩子们通过观察、触摸和交流,了 解米饭的软糯和海苔的香脆。接着,孩子们在 老师的指导下动手制作饭团: 舀米饭、添加海 苔、搅拌混合,放进容器,使劲儿摇晃。个个都 兴致勃勃,认真投入。最后,孩子们品尝了自 己亲手制作的海苔饭团,纷纷表示"好吃极 ,赞不绝口,不仅体验了动手的乐趣,也 发了对美食的兴趣。



身边的职业,幼儿一班的小朋友通过学习, 了解了消防车的特殊用途、外形特征。手工 制作—消防车,表达了小朋友们对消防员 这一职业的尊敬和热爱。



在学习传统食物茶叶蛋的活动中,老师首先带领孩 子们一起认识煮茶叶蛋所需要的材料,如鸡蛋、茶 叶、八角、酱油等,孩子们通过观察、闻一闻等方式 初步了解这些食材的特点。随后,老师详细讲解并 展示了煮茶叶蛋的过程,从清洗鸡蛋、煮熟敲裂,到 放入调料再次炖煮,孩子们对茶叶蛋的制作过程有 了更清晰的认识。最后,在老师的引导下,孩子们亲 手体验了剥鸡蛋壳的乐趣,感受鸡蛋表皮的变化, 并品尝了自己"参与制作"的茶叶蛋,既满足了味 蕾,也加深了对传统食物的理解与喜爱。

MALAY LANGUAGE CLASSES

Peringkat Asuhan

Murid-murid telah mempelajari tentang dua jenis epal, iaitu epal merah dan epal hijau. Bagi menjadikan pembelajaran lebih menyeronokkan dan bermakna, mereka dibahagikan kepada dua kumpulan untuk meneroka kedua-dua jenis epal yang disediakan di dalam sebuah mangkuk. Satu permainan interaktif telah dijalankan di mana muridmurid diminta mencari gambar epal yang telah disembunyikan oleh guru di sekitar bilik darjah kelas Melayu.



Tajaka 1

Murid-murid Tajaka 1 berpeluang merasa pelbagai jenis buah-buahan yang dibekalkan oleh ibu bapa. Mereka sangat teruja kerana dapat merasa buah-buahan yang mempunyai pelbagai rasa, termasuk yang masam dan manis. Aktiviti ini bukan sahaja menyeronokkan, malah turut memberi pendedahan kepada murid tentang kepelbagaian jenis buah tempatan serta khasiatnya yang menyumbangkan kepada kesihatan.

Tajaka 2

Murid-murid menikmati pembelajaran tentang makanan berkhasiat di kelas! Guru memperkenalkan buah-buahan segar seperti strawberi, pisang dan anggur. Sambil menyusun buah menggunakan lidi kecil, mereka belajar bahawa strawberi mengandungi vitamin C, pisang memberi tenaga dan anggur membantu tubuh kekal sihat. Murid-murid turut mencuba dan menikmati hasil tusuk buah buatan sendiri. Aktiviti ini menggalakkan pemahaman tentang pemakanan sihat melalui permainan, sentuhan dan rasa, menjadikan pembelajaran lebih menyeronokkan dan bermakna!
