Stories Come Alive!

D.E.E.P Project (Little Bloom)

The teacher read 'The Rainbow Fish' to our toddlers, who listened attentively and enjoyed the story. Provide Controlled Choices

Offer two alternatives that you are completely happy with. This gives children a healthy sense of autonomy while avoiding frustrating power struggles.

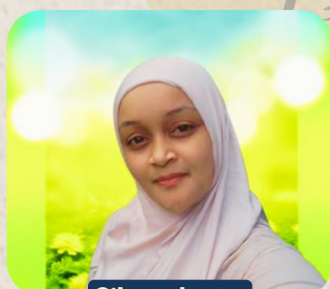
