

# Preschool News

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The toddlers learnt about recycled materials through a variety of activities. 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Nursery 1 Recycle Project (\*\*)

Our little ones explored the importance of recycling through hands-on fun! They made collages, flowers from bread tags, and crafted their own Recycle Heroes and Recycle Trucks. They also brought recyclables from home and helped place them in the bins outside our school. A meaningful project to nurture eco-friendly habits early!

















During our Term 2 D.E.E.P Project, N2 children delved into the topic of "Saving the Earth" where they focused on the 3Rs: Reduce, Reuse & Recycle. The children discussed different ways in practising the 3Rs and translating them into action such as bringing their own lunchboxes, reducing water usage, playing bowling using recycled bottles and sharing different items that they can reuse/reduce. They also created a small corner in their classroom for their recyclable Tetra Pak cartons!






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#### 1. Craft: Trash No More

The children created a meaningful craft using recycled materials which featured their own photo holding up the planet proudly.

### 2. Graph Activity: What do we throw away the most?

We gathered data and created graphs to find out the type of items we throw away the most at home and in school.

#### 3. Group Work: Recycling Process

In groups, the children drew and presented the recycling journey – showing how rubbish can become something new!

#### 4. What is rubbish?

The children sorted everyday items into "trash" and "recyclable" to learn what can be given a new life and what truly belongs in the bin.








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The K2 children took part in a series of engaging activities centred around recycling and the use of recyclable materials. As a class, they brainstormed what they already knew about the 3Rs and shared ideas on how to care for the Earth. To reinforce their understanding of graphs, they used recyclable items to create visual representations, and practised sorting different materials into categories. One of the highlights was an exciting outdoor game called 'Bin Tag', where the children had to dash to the correct recycling bin before getting tagged by a friend.

#### Visit the library:

Introduce them to the library and encourage them to participate in story time programs.

# Making Reading Fun and Engaging:

Use different voices and expressions:

Bring the characters to life with different voices and inflections.

#### Connect to their lives:

Relate the stories to their own experiences and ask questions that encourage them to think about the story.

## Act out the story:

Use props or puppets to make the story more engaging and interactive.

#### Let them choose:

Allow your child to choose the books they want to read, even if it's the same one over and over again.
