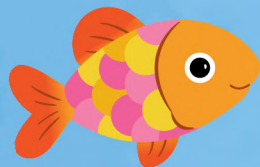


## Deepavali Awareness Day

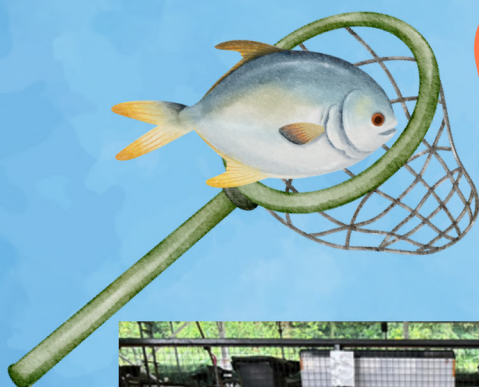

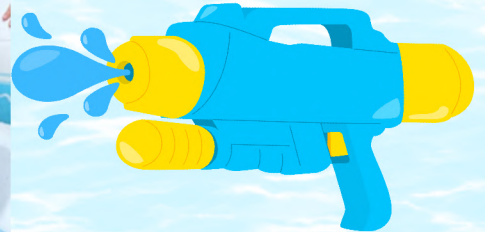
## Toddler Class Disposition Day

Toddler 1A delighted in scooping water and watching balloons float in a water play activity that developed their hand-eye coordination. They certainly had fun too!

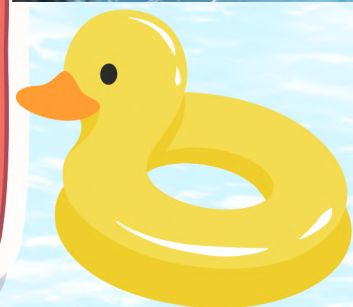




## Nursery 1 Class Disposition Day

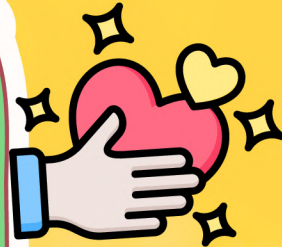




## K1A Class Disposition Day

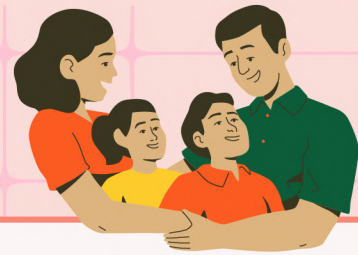


### Tadika 2
