LITTLE BLOOM LEARNING JOURNEY TO JOLLY JUNGLE PLAYGROUND

Our little ones, along with their parents, embarked on an exciting first Learning Journey into the magical Jolly Jungle. This adventure was designed to foster self-discovery and peer interaction, allowing our curious explorers to learn more about themselves and each other in a safe and playful setting. They navigated the mini jungle gym designed for tiny adventurers with much excitement! With gentle slopes, soft climbing structures, and safe spaces to crawl and toddle, the little ones built confidence and gross motor skills as they applied their physical abilities.



The enjoyment was not limited to the children as parents were also provided with a special activity designed for bonding. They participated in a mini-bingo game titled 'Find Someone Who...!', where each square presented a description and participants had to locate a parent who fit that description. This interactive game successfully fostered connections and conversations among the parents.



WARISAN BUDAYA

Aktiviti Warisan Budaya pada penggal ini memperkenalkan tulisan Jawi. Murid-murid mempelajari bahawa tulisan Jawi masih digunakan di beberapa tempat hingga kini. Mereka berpeluang melihat contoh-contoh penulisan Jawi daripada pelbagai sumber seperti surat khabar dan tanda jalan. Mereka juga bermain aktiviti di mana mereka mencari pasangan berdasarkan nama yang mempunyai huruf Jawi yang sama, diikuti dengan sesi mewarnakan nama mereka yang ditulis dalam tulisan Jawi.



Tadika 1 telah mempelajari nilai murni menghormati ibu bapa melalui aktiviti lakonan. Mereka bergilir-gilir memainkan watak sebagai ibu bapa dan juga anak-anak. Antara lakonan yang dipersembahkan ialah watak anak yang sering membantah dan menjawab, serta watak anak yang sentiasa mendengar dan menghormati ibu bapa.

Bagi menghidupkan lagi suasana, murid-murid Tadika 1 mengenakan pakaian tradisional seperti baju batik, kain pelikat dan pakaian ala ibu atau nenek. Kemudian, mereka berkongsi perasaan dan refleksi mereka. Melalui pengalaman ini, mereka memahami kepentingan menghormati ibu bapa. Mereka juga mula menyedari bahawa ibu bapa berusaha keras setiap hari dan akan berasa sedih sekiranya usaha serta pengorbanan mereka tidak dihargai.



Untuk sesi Warisan Budaya ini, murid-murid berpeluang untuk merasa kuih tradisional Melayu seperti ondeh-ondeh, putri salat dan epok-epok. Mereka kemudian membuat kuih-muih menggunakan doh yang berwarna warni.

TEA SESSION CUM PARENTAL WORKSHOP

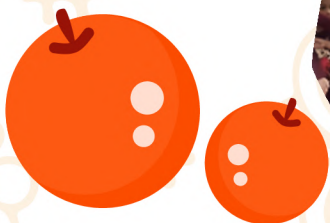

TODDLER B

'WALK THE LINE'



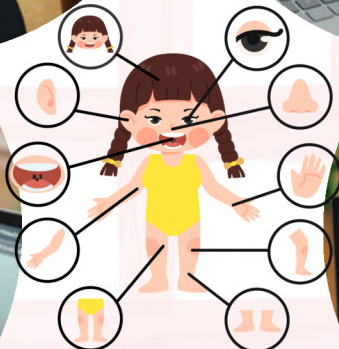
Toddler B participated in the 'Walk the Line' activity, carefully stepping along the line while practising balance and coordination. They showed focus and determination as they made their way from one end to the other. This activity supported the development of Toddler B's body control and confidence, while also strengthening their gross motor skills in a fun and engaging way.





NURSERY 1A

Our N1A children had a fun time learning about their body parts, and enjoyed making funny and silly faces. Using photos contributed by parents, the children re-enacted their playful and silly expressions which made the activity more lighthearted and lively. They were also able to identify parts of their face such as the eyes, nose, mouth, and ears. Through this activity, the children developed better awareness of their body parts and improved their confidence in expressing themselves. The activity also encouraged interaction between children and parents while creating a joyful learning experience.





NURSERY 1B

Our N1B children had an fulfilling term of learning! They explored colour-matching during numeracy, strengthened their fine motor skills in an activity where attempted to remove clips, and participated in simple exercises while lying down. They were also introduced to the concept of 'No Littering' and learnt the importance of keeping their environment clean. Overall, the children showed great curiosity, growing confidence, and joy as they actively participated in their learning experiences.





NURSERY 2A

Stack & Count: Count 1 to 10!

Building on their familiarity with counting from 1 to 5, our N2A children were introduced to a new challenge! Each child was given a number card from 1 to 10 and used snap-tubes to connect pieces that matched the number shown. After completing their builds, they took turns sharing with their peers the number they received, and the number of snap-tubes they used, demonstrating their growing confidence in counting and number representation.



Shape Mural Painting - Using toilet roll spools to create printed shapes, the children explored and expressed their feelings through art. They were encouraged to understand that there are no right or wrong shapes or colours, allowing them to freely experiment and express their creativity with confidence!



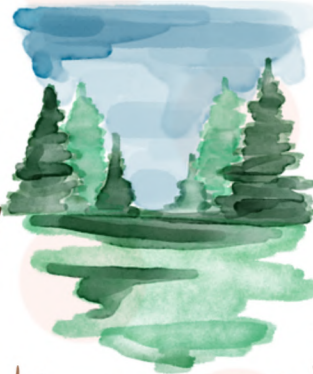


NURSERY 2B

Reading - Using the KeyLinks book titled 'Look at the Web', our N2B children were encouraged to recall the sight words: 'in', 'at' and 'look'. They took turns to look for the words in the book, and later played a game of 'musical parcel'. This game encouraged children to identify the word on the stick while also getting them to recall the word.



Nature Magnified - The children explored using natural materials to make a nature brush. They collected different types of leaves and twigs from the garden, and later went back to class to gather them in a bundle to make a brush. They then used their special brush to create a painting using lines and strokes. From this activity, the children built on their creativity and learnt to be appreciative of the natural environment.



KINDERGARTEN IB

Number Conservation Activity

In this activity, children explored the concept of number conservation, where they understood that a number remains the same even when it is arranged in different ways. Each group was assigned a number and used pipe cleaners to creatively represent it.

After completing their designs, the children participated in a gallery walk where they observed one another's work and counted together. Through this activity, they discovered that although the shapes and arrangements of the pipe cleaners looked different, the quantity remained the same. It was a wonderful way for the children to learn collaboratively while having their early numeracy skills and creativity supported as well.



KINDERGARTEN 2A

In the topic about 'My Self', our K2A children took a closer look at each other's features as they drew a portrait of their friend. From this activity, they got to observe and discover that facial features differ from one person to the next.



The children engaged in a fun and interactive subitizing activity, where they were challenged to quickly recognise numbers presented in different forms, such as dot patterns and finger representations. They then had to think on their feet and select the correct number card from the floor. This activity helped to strengthen their number sense, visual recognition, and quick thinking skills in an enjoyable and engaging way.



The children participated in an engaging phonics game where they listened carefully to words and identified the correct initial consonant sound. They then positioned themselves accordingly. For example, for the word 'glide,' the children placed themselves after the letter 'G'. This activity supported their listening skills, phonemic awareness, and understanding of letter-sound relationships in a fun and active way.





KINDERGARTEN 2B

During our K2B's Nature Magnified lesson, the children discovered the wonders of aloe vera and learnt about its soothing properties, such as its use as a cooling gel. They engaged their senses by feeling its unique texture and applying it gently on their hands. To extend their learning, the children also participated in preparing aloe vera ice cubes, making the experience both fun and refreshing!



During their Crafty Art session, the children tried their hand in making a Painter's Tape Art masterpiece! They used tape to create different spaces on their paper before colouring within the sections. Upon removing the tape, their own unique abstract artwork was revealed!



The children participated in a Discovery of the World activity to learn about the sense of sight. While blindfolded, they guessed the objects placed in front of them using their other senses. They then shared how they felt during the activity, and made connections to the experiences of individuals who are visually impaired.
