Nature Magnified – Tech Tools

We are excited to introduce a variety of technology tools that will enrich our children's learning experiences. By integrating technology meaningfully into nature-based learning, we hope to inspire our young learners to become confident explorers of both nature and innovation.

Our children will have the opportunity to create using a 3D pen, capture their observations with a children's digital camera, and discover how plants grow through a hydroponics planting system. These tools will complement hands-on investigations, encouraging children to observe closely, document their findings, express their creativity, and deepen their understanding of the natural world.

Parenting Tips

Current issue: Too much unsupervised screen use → delays in speech, short attention span, poor social skills

Screen Time Tips for Happy Kids!



1. Follow MOH guidelines: **max 1 hour/day** for ages 2–6; no screens 1 hour before bed or during meals.



2. **Watch together**, not alone — talk about what you see to build language.



3. **Never use screens to** 'distract' or calm tantrums; replace with toys, books, or outdoor play.



4. **Set clear rules:** "Tablet only after playtime / homework"

Following good screen time guidelines helps children develop clearer speech and language, improve their focus, build better social skills, enjoy restful sleep, and strengthen their connection with family.
