

HIGHER EDUCATION EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND REPORTING FOR EMERGENCY FINANCIAL AID GRANTS TO STUDENTS

Under the reporting guidelines established by the Department of Education's Office of Postsecondary Education, concerning Section 18004 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) and the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students, Hair Academy. submits the following information:

1. This statement shall serve to acknowledge that our institution signed and returned to the US Department of Education the *Certification and Agreement – Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students*. We further attest that our institution has used, and/or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
2. The total amount of funds that Hair Academy, Inc. has received from the Department according to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Student is \$477,964 for OPE ID 02333000.
3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of March 1, 2022, is \$281,295 for OPE ID 02333000.
4. The estimated total number of students at our institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is 220 for OPE ID 02333000.
5. The methodology used by our institution to determine which students can receive the Emergency Financial Aid Grants is for any student that completed hours and is considered currently attending an approved program, must have a FAFSA on file, and cannot be in default. After confirming the Title IV eligibility requirements, the institution retains discretion over which students will receive HEERF-student share funds. The funds will be distributed under Section 18004 (a)(1) of the CARES Act.
6. Students should contact the Business Manager on student's eligibility to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and detailed guidance on how to claim their grant funds.
