- Increase Property Value & Rent Potential, and Provide Residents with a High-Value Amenity and Convenient Solution for Managing Food Waste




Summary

- This program evaluated the effectiveness and logistics of decentralized organic waste management in NexLiving Communities and Devcore multi-residential properties.
- After just a few months, results showed that the developers' objectives were being achieved; Namely, reducing the amount of waste generated and providing sustainable waste management options that tenants loved.

With 155 FoodCyclers In Use, Results Indicated





The FoodCycler reduces the weight and volume of food waste by up to 90%, producing a shelf-stable material that is free of contamination. This makes the material significantly easier to store, transport, and manage on-site, supporting cost-effective handling and helping properties avoid fees associated with curbside organic waste.



Use of Foodilizer (By-product)

On-site Foodilizer bins were the preferred option for by-product management, with 72% of tenants using them. Others share or reuse Foodilizer for gardening uses, reinforcing the program's circular benefits.
