Jenny Stojkovic didn't grow up with CEO parents, Ivy League connections, or a financial safety net. Raised in a small Canadian farm town by a blind father and a mother who worked as a grocery store cashier, she learned early that nothing is handed to you, you have to build it yourself.

That mindset, which she later coined the Why Not Me? philosophy, propelled her from humble beginnings to the heart of Silicon Valley. There, she led global policy work for companies like Google, Meta, and Airbnb and built a reputation as a trusted voice at the intersection of business, technology, and policy.

Today, Jenny is one of the youngest female venture capitalists in the U.S., serving as General Partner of Joyful Ventures, and has invested over \$25 million into early-stage, values-driven startups.


