Summary:

Resource West is seeking a Production Assembler to help build, test, and install water evaporation equipment and related components. Work may involve bench assembly, shop floor tasks, and occasional field travel (sometimes on short notice). Welding experience (TIG, MIG, Stick) is a plus but not required. A clean motor vehicle record is required.

Responsibilities:

- Assemble metal, non-metal, and electrical parts using blueprints, tools, and fasteners.
- Operate equipment such as forklifts, cranes, drill presses, welders, and hand tools.
- Prepare equipment for shipment, including international orders.
- Assist with quality control and collaborate with engineering on improvements.
- Pick up and deliver parts from local vendors.
- Follow safety procedures and maintain a clean, organized work area.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or GED; or one to three months of related experience/training; or equivalent combination.
- Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating instructions, and procedure manuals.
- Ability to write routine reports and correspondence.
- Basic math skills: add, subtract, multiply, divide using whole numbers, fractions, and decimals; ability to compute rate, ratio, and percent.
- Ability to read and interpret simple as-built drawings.
- Ability to apply common sense to carry out written, oral, or diagram instructions and solve problems with several variables.
- Must be able to lift up to 40 lbs and perform physical tasks such as standing, walking, bending,



kneeling, and reaching.

- Welding experience and/or Spanish language skills are a plus.

Work Environment & Physical Demands:

- Shop and field setting with exposure to moving machinery, vibration, outdoor weather, and occasional electrical hazards.
- Moderate noise level.
- Requires regular standing, walking, and use of hands; occasional climbing, balancing, and crouching.
- Must maintain close and distance vision, depth perception, and focus adjustment.
