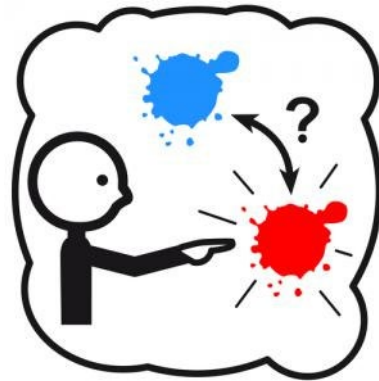


Choices, Rights and Responsibilities

Everyone has **choices**



An example of a **choice** is deciding what clothes you are going to wear



Another **choice** is deciding which person you would like to talk to



Everyone has **rights**



A **right** is something you are entitled to have, and no one can take away



You can read about your **rights** in the *International Agreement on the rights of Disabled People*



Everyone has **responsibilities**



A **responsibility** is something you have to do



You have the **responsibility** to treat people with respect



Treating people with respect means

- Not being mean to people



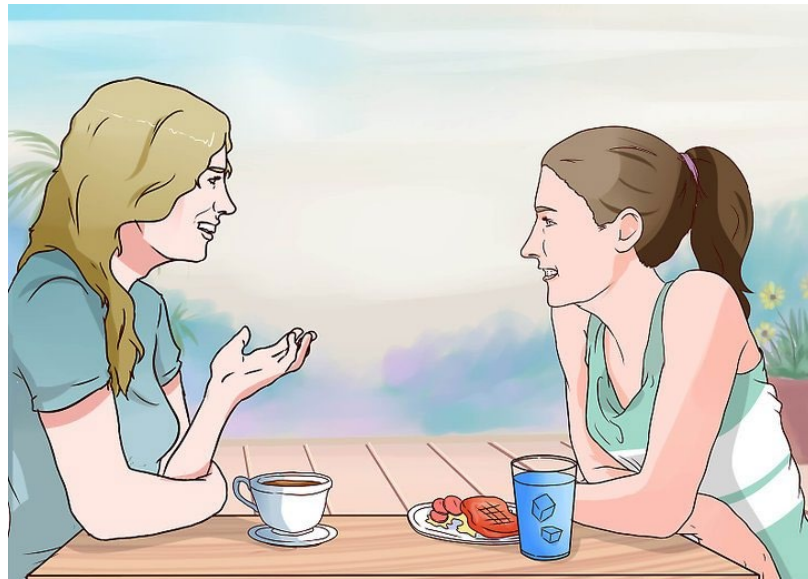
- Tolerating people's opinions



- Not making fun of people



- Speaking nicely to people



- Not yelling or swearing at people



- Let other people make their own choices



- Taking turns speaking



You have the **responsibility** not to hurt other people



You have the **responsibility** to respect other people's property



You have the **responsibility** not to take other people's things



There are other examples of **choices** and **responsibilities**

You have the **choice** to clean your teeth



You have the **responsibility** if your teeth need fillings



You have a **choice** to live in your house



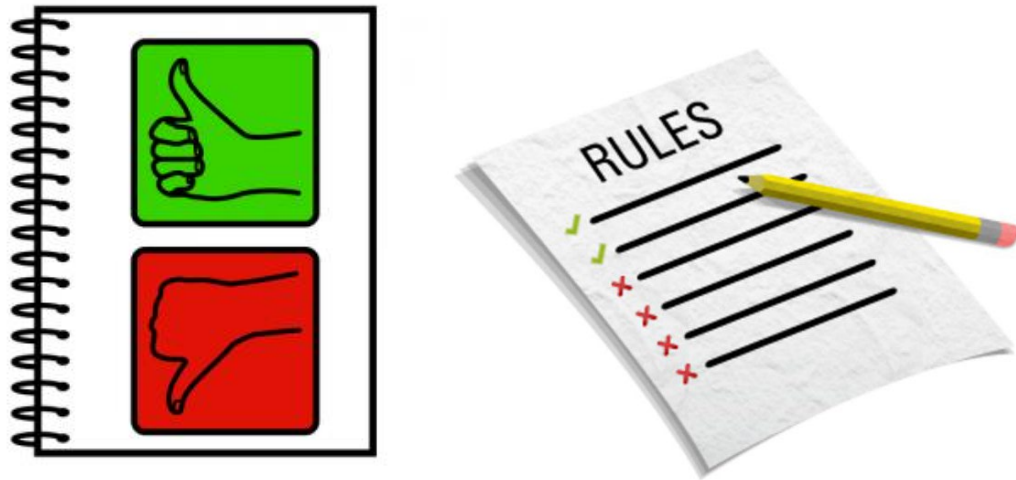
You have a **responsibility** to keep your house clean

You have the **responsibility** to follow the rules



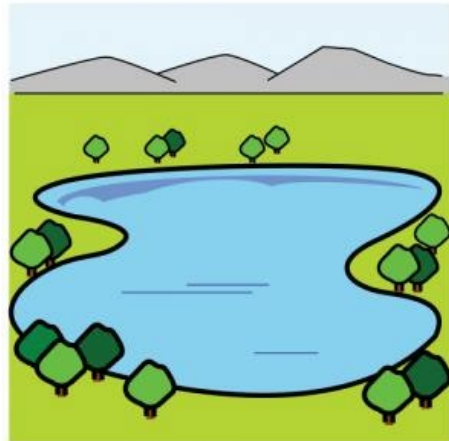
You have a **choice** to go out
