

Visiting the Dentist

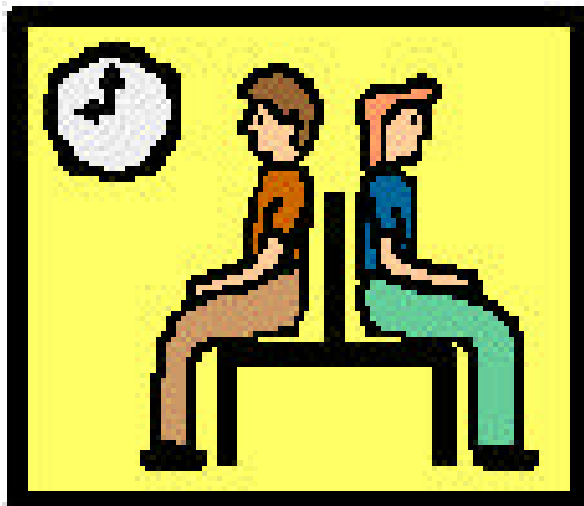


We are going to visit the Dentist.

We will sit waiting in the reception chair,



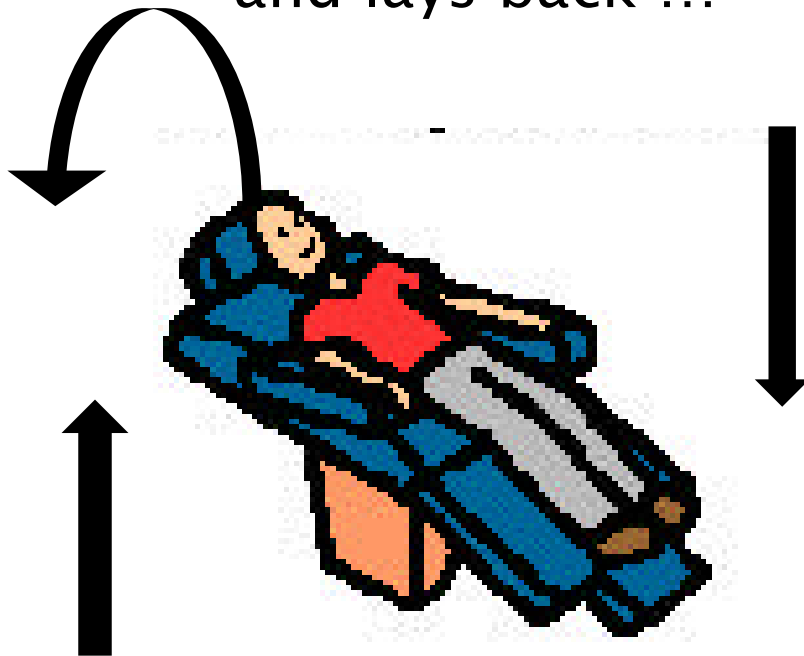
then you can ...

Here are some of the tools

To begin, the Dentist will ...



... turn the light on.

... and put a bib

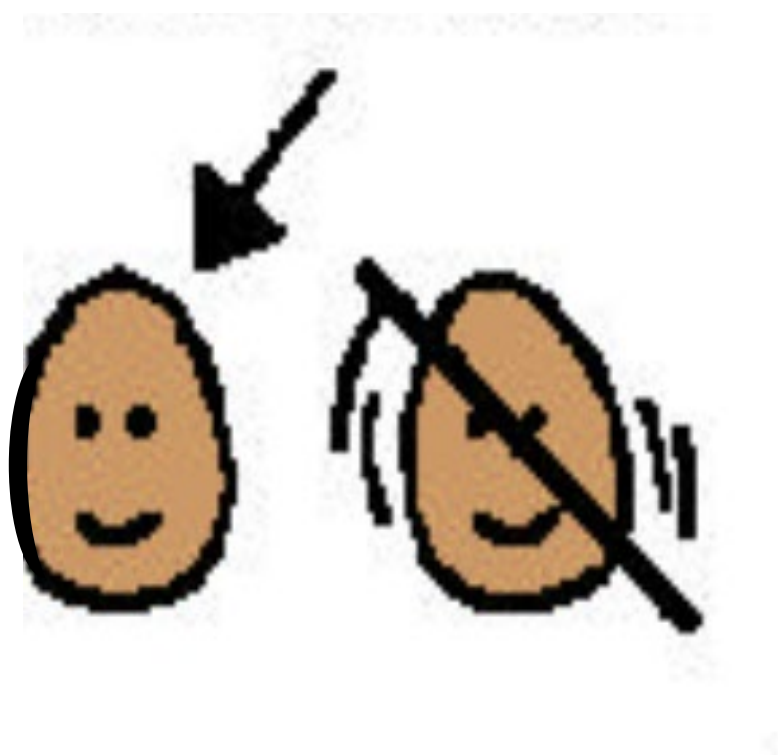


around your

open your mouth wide ...



... and keep your head still...



...so your teeth can be counted.



Well Done!

The Dentist might take a photo of your teeth



from the inside.

A small item will be placed in your mouth



and you will have to bite down on it.

A picture of the inside of your mouth
will appear on screen.





Great job.

The Dentist will use a probe to poke
around between your teeth ...



... and a mirror
to look for holes in your teeth.



These holes make your teeth hurt.





The Dentist will fix the sore teeth and
you will feel better soon.

The Dentist might give a little gas ...



... or a needle



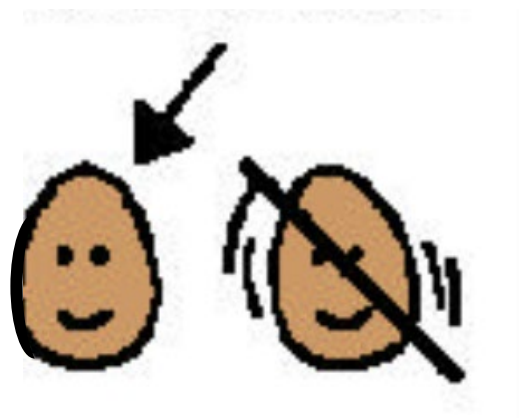
to stop the tooth hurting,
while it gets fixed.

You need to open wide again



and

keep holding
your head still.



The Dentist will clean out the hole



and put stuff in called 'filling'.

This is what fillings look like



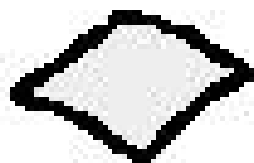
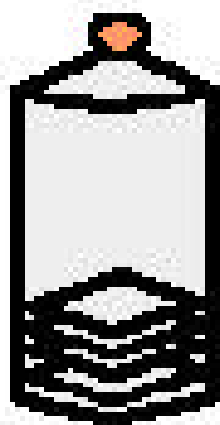
in your teeth.

The Dentist will press the filling down
with the rubber tip

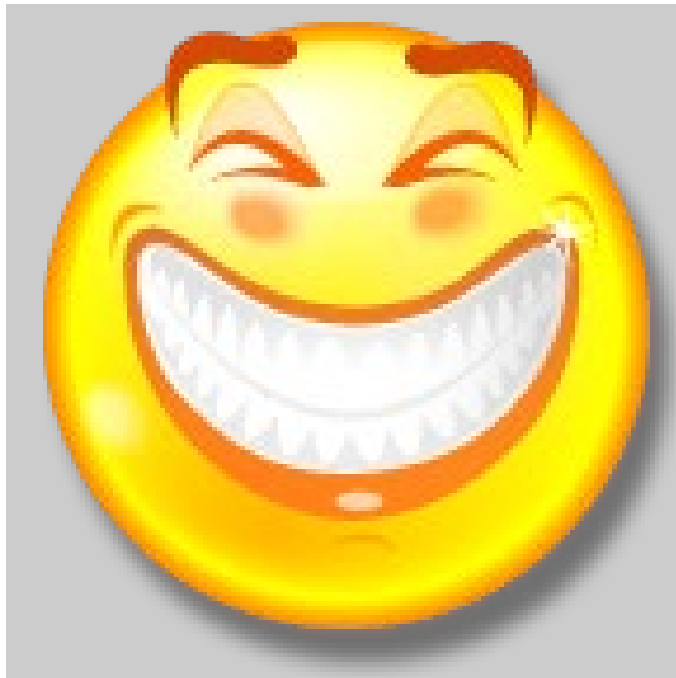


to fill the hole up ...

... and might put things in your mouth

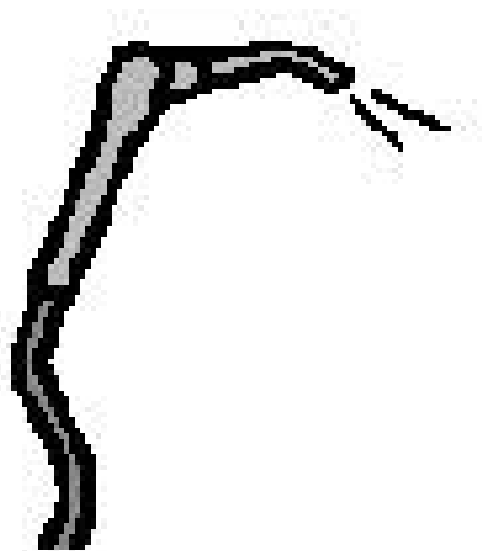


and ask you to bite down.



Good Job!

The Dentist will blow air and water



in your mouth...

... then ask you to spit it out in the cup
or basin.
