Tournament Rules – 5-6 Division 2 8 Team Pool Play + Championship

1. Format

- 8 teams are divided into 2 pools of 4 teams each (Pool Purple & Pool Orange).
- Group Stage (Pool Play):
 - Each team plays every other team in their pool once.
 - 4 teams per pool = 6 matches in each pool (12 total group stage matches).
 - Each team plays 3 matches.
- Championship Game:
 - The 1st place team from Pool Orange plays the 1st place team from Purple to determine the champion.

2. Match Rules

- FIFA Laws of the Game apply, except where modified by SSSL Rules
- No overtime or penalty shootouts in the group stage—matches may end in a draw.
- Seeded games must have a winner: If tied at the end of regulation → Penalty kicks (no extra time).

3. Points System (Group Stage)

- Win = 3 points
- Draw = 1 point
- Loss = 0 points

4. Tiebreakers (Group Stage Standings)

If two or more teams in a pool are tied on points:

- 1. **Head-to-head result** (between tied teams)
- 2. **Goal difference** (goals scored minus goals conceded)
- 3. Goals scored
- 4. Fewest goals conceded
- 5. Coin toss

5. Final Standings - Winner and Runner Up Determined by Final
