2. What helps you to see the light again and to persevere in the face of difficulties? What is the source of your hope?
3. In Ephesians 5:19-21, it states that we should be “Giving thanks always for all things”. Do you think that this is more achievable in the midst of singing as the verse suggests? Read Colossians 3:16 and contemplate how to “Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly”.
4. Which song do you find yourself humming or singing when you are seeking the Lord? Can you share with the group a key line or phrase that is meaningful to you?
5. Martin Rinkart wrote the song “Now Thank We all our God” as an expression of his faith and thankfulness in God. If you had the time and skill to write a song, what would be the theme of your song?
