

- 1. Hercules, Zeus
- 2. "This Son of Man whom you have seen is the One who would remove the kings and the mighty ones from their comfortable seats and the strong ones from their thrones. He shall loosen the reins of the strong and crush the teeth of the sinners."
- (1 Enoch 46:4; 71:14 The Son of Man is Enoch)

Who Is God?

1 Cor 8:6, "But to us there is but <u>one God, the Father</u>, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u>, by whom are all things, and we by him."

"In a relatively short period of time, with imperial assistance, and soon thereafter [God as the Trinity] was considered a nonnegotiable, and moreover something which had always been clearly taught in scripture." -Tuggy

"Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else. I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear. Surely, shall one say, in [Yahweh] have I righteousness and strength: even to him shall men come; and all that are incensed against him shall be ashamed. "The Jesus who emerges then is a Jesus who said and did what only God could say and do. His claims are unmatched by Jewish expectations of the Messiah, by Jewish ideas regarding the glorious characters of Israel's past, the most exalted of the angels, and even the heavenly Son of Man. According to the contemporary Jewish sources, these divine agents do not engage Satan directly, and they do not [muster in] the new creation. They do not forgive sins, and they do not autonomously pass the ultimate, [final end-time] judgment. They do not pit their own authority against the authority of the word of God. Nor do they demand a loyalty that takes precedence over the commandments of God."

0. Jesus is the pre-existent creator

Created by Word/Wisdom

Psalm 33:6 "By the word of [Yahweh] were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth."

Proverbs 8:22 "The Lord possessed me [Wisdom] in the beginning of his way, before his works of old. 23 I was set up from everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the earth was... 27 When he prepared the heavens, <u>I was there</u>: when he set a compass upon the face of the depth:... 30 Then I was by him, as one brought up with him: and I was daily his delight, rejoicing always before him."

Wisdom of Solomon 7 "22 ... wisdom, the fashioner of all things,... 25 is a breath of the power of God, and a pure emanation of the glory of the Almighty; therefore nothing defiled gains entrance into her. 26 For she is a reflection of eternal light, a spotless mirror of the working of God, and an image of his goodness. 27 Although she is but one, she can do all things, and while remaining in herself, she renews all things" (NRSV).

Conclusion

"He remained Lord of all things even when he came [entering our likeness] in the form of a slave, and this is why the mystery of Christ is truly wonderful. Indeed God the Father said to the Jews through one of the prophets: "Look on this you scoffers, be struck with wonder and disappear, for I am doing a work in your days, a work in which you will not believe even if one were to explain it to you" (Hab 1:5; Acts 13:41). Indeed the mystery of Christ runs the risk of being disbelieved precisely because it is so incredibly wonderful."


