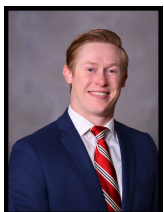

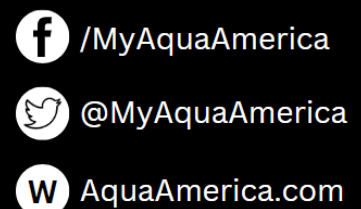
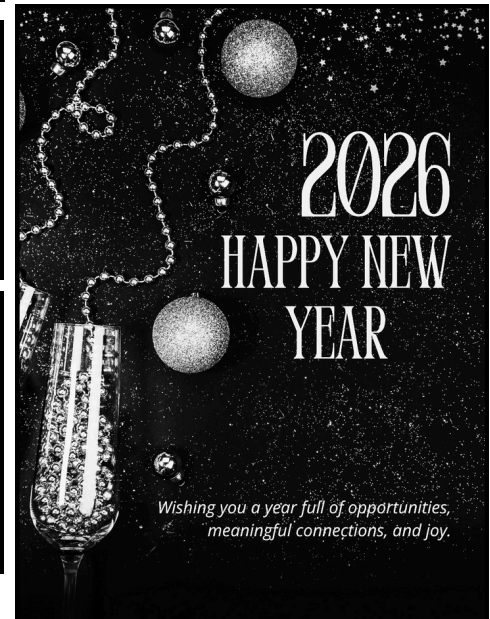

Centuries of Stories: Start Celebrating Massillon's Bicentennial!

A free fun evening at the Lions Lincoln Theatre will launch Massillon's Bicentennial celebration on Saturday, January 17, from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. Everyone is welcome and no reservations are required. The event is casual. Just drop in or stay for the entire time.

Continuous films of Massillon's past will intrigue guests. Some have sound, like a narration by hometown hero David Canary. Others are silent, but local historian and showman Rudy Turkal will comment on some of the action. Interspersed with the films, he and fellow historian Margy Vogt will proffer trivia questions about the community's past. Guests can play for "fabulous" prizes.

Films include footage of skating on the reservoir, fires, the Sugar Bowl, the Paul Brown and Red Bird era, then-and-now cityscapes, football traditions, businesses, and a parade of all the elementary school children from 1940. See old businesses, the 1948 Tremont viaduct dedication, and the underground bathrooms.

Some films are from Turkal's private collection; others are provided by the Massillon Museum. Local historian and MassMu archivist Mandy Altimus Stahl will compile the best of the films for three separate screens and contribute additional some of her own local knowledge.

Watch for details about a contest at the event for the best team shirts bearing Massillon sponsors' names.

Popcorn and soft drinks will be available for purchase in the theatre's concession area.

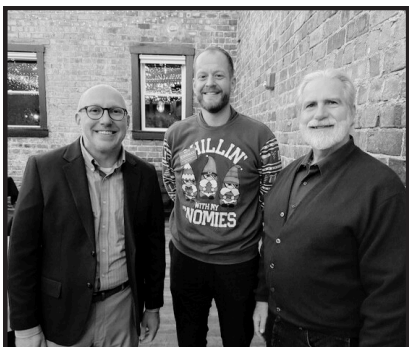
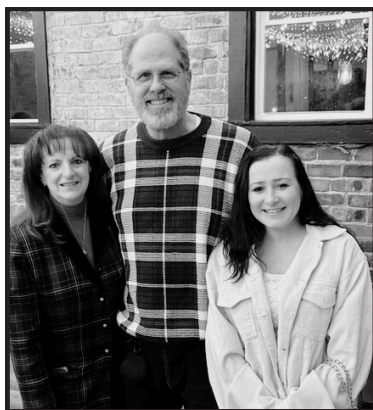

Massillon Community Charitable Fund

Massillon Community Charitable Fund, a component fund of Stark Community Foundation, is accepting grant applications from area organizations starting Monday December 29, 2025 until Monday, February 16, 2026 at 4:30 p.m.

Massillon Community Charitable Fund awards grants annually to local organizations making a difference in Western Stark County. A seven-member advisory committee, made up of Massillon area residents, reviews grants proposals and makes all funding decisions.

In order to be considered for funding, grant applicants must be a 501(c)(3) organization in good standing with the IRS. Requests will also be considered from tax-exempt private agencies and government entities. Proposals must benefit residents living in Western Stark County, may not exceed \$4,000 and must be submitted electronically by completing a grant application online.
