General discussion without motions:

Guests—Pat Zehring went around the room giving each guest the opportunity to speak. All present to observe and gather info.

4-H reports – Megan Brittingham passed out Rabbit Species rules for approval. Board decided to review and vote at November meeting She thanked Andy Derr for cleaning out the French drain in front of the OSU Building thus removing the mini pond!

Jr. Fair Report—no report currently.

Secretary Minutes—Liz Jordan emailed and passed out for Board review and approval.

Treasurers Report—Sara O’Banion passed out bank statements and payroll summary for Board review and approval. She went over the handouts explaining figures.

Sheila Bloom—Representing the Greene County Board of Developmental Disabilities spoke on the adult changing tables/trailer. They have been checking into costs and find that it is much higher than originally anticipated. She is open for suggestions on how to proceed stating they are looking for a small building or trailer that could be converted. The changing table itself can be purchased for roughly \$1800. Johnny Wooten suggested a ticket shed we no longer use that could be converted. He will meet with Sheila to show her the building and discuss.
