“Special” Board of Directors Meeting
December 8, 2025

Members Present: A special board meeting was held on December 8th at 6:30 pm.

Steve Dailey updated the board on the Horse arena contract stating that the Executive Committee has discussed the contract and are recommending to the board that we **Do NOT** sign it at this time. The benefits of the project are not favorable to us as a board and the risks of it being taken over by the commissioners is too high which would leave us in a bad situation with no horse arena at all. Cindy Gould expressed concerns regarding the vote that had taken place in a previous meeting allowing the project to continue. Johnny Wooten explained that no one had seen the contract at that time and were allowing the planning to continue and were trusting the committee to look out for the best interest of the board. Objections continued from Cindy but upon further review of the contract the Board have all agreed and decided not to continue.

The sales dinner location at the fair was discussed. Whitney wants to have it in the assembly building stating it would be much more convenient with the kitchen close and the overall location, bathrooms, and nice building. They feel the building isn't that full during the fair and can easily be moved on Thursday at the close of the fair for dinner on Friday. that area can then be released back to the fair for Saturday. Megan, Aaron and Pat explained their concerns about the non-livestock participants getting squeezed out of the only building they occupy at fair. After discussion it was voted 6 to 3 to allow the dinner to take place in the half of the building towards fairground road. Whitney will make plenty of signage for sending people to the entrance on that side of the building across from the admin building.

The location of the rides was discussed and unanimously voted to move them back to their previous location with some adjustments to be discussed and determined as we move on. Andy states he will leave the concessions and rides camping where it has been moved too and will remove the rest of the concessions camping from the area behind the extension office. He will then put the row of fair campers in the spots the concessions had occupied opening that row up again for rides. The concessions campers that remained in the Camping Area behind the Concession last year will be moved up front with the rest of the rides and concession camping. This will allow him to move the camping folks from the extension area back into the campground area.

Motion made to go into executive session to discuss employee contracts. attendance was taken by Liz Jordan. Sara and Liz then left the session.
