

Shepherd's Voice.

From Transfiguration..... to Resurrection.


There are 2 important connected events in the life of Jesus. First is the Transfiguration – a joyful event. And 2nd, is the crucifixion-a sorrowful and heartbreaking event. The transfiguration and crucifixion events in the life of Jesus send us the message that life is a checkered lights and shadows, joys and sorrows.

What does this mean to us in our Christian life? When they were still at the top of Mount Tabor, the disciples requested that they would just stay there. In their minds, they wanted that life would always be a transfiguration. But Jesus said... NO! we have to go down to the plains and climb another mountain....to Mount Calvary (the mountain of Crucifixion). Jesus necessarily has to come down from the mountain of transfiguration so that He can go up to the mountain of crucifixion; for he knew that if he won't carry the cross and suffer greatly until his death... he won't reach the resurrection. Jesus knew that the greatest transfiguration is: ***resurrection from the dead, life after death... the transfiguration to life everlasting.***

This is the message God wants to remind us: In his immeasurable love, today He wants us to accompany Jesus in Mt. Tabor; tomorrow, He leads us to be with Jesus at the foot of the cross in Mt. Calvary. All of these we need to undergo so that we can truly live as God's children like Jesus. Then we can hope to hear the voice of the Heavenly Father:

“These are my beloved children, in whom I am well-pleased.”

Jesus Shows His Glory




In today's Gospel reading Jesus took three of His apostles up a mountain and gave them a vision of His true glory. He shone as bright as the sun- so bright they could hardly look at Him. But did you know that what they saw was only a tiny bit of the true glory of God?

It was so beautiful that Peter wanted Him to stay that way. He offered to build tents for Jesus and Moses and Elijah, who appeared with Him. But the joy of that moment wasn't meant to last forever. It was just a little taste of Heaven.

Jesus gave this experience to the three apostles just a little while before He went to Jerusalem to suffer and die on the cross. He knew that they would be terrified and very sad when He died so He gave them a preview of the glory He would go back to after He rose from the dead. That way they knew they had a reason to hope even when He was killed.

Sometimes we have awful things to suffer through too. Maybe a friend will move away or one of our grandparents will die. But we never have to give up hope because we know that eventually everyone who loves Jesus will live in total happiness in Heaven.
