# Shepherd's Voice®

## A JOURNEY OF ENCOUNTERING THE RISEN LORD

Our Gospel is a kind of Journey story. Two disciples were on the road to Emmaus, discussing the recent events. St. Luke tells us that they did not recognize the Lord right away when He walked with them. Only after they sat at table with him and he broke the bread were their eyes opened.

We go through different journeys in life with predetermined purposes. Some journeys are intended for us to see places for the first time, encounter another culture, or meet new friends. Other journeys are meant to rest our tired bodies. At other times, we go on a journey to travel back in time, revisit familiar sights, and rekindle memories. Regardless of purpose, a journey can be two- directional: outward or inward.

Initially, the journey of the two disciples from Jerusalem to Emmaus and back was about creating a physical distance between the location of a horrible incident they just witnessed and where they thought it would be a place of refuge. Feeling lost and dejected, they decided to leave Jerusalem. In their darkest hour, the Lord manifested his presence to them, slowly restoring their hope and faith in him.

The value and worth of our journeys in life is not measured by their financial cost alone. The whole point of a journey is not the journey itself, nor the destination; but what becomes of us and what it does to us. The disciples' journey was a walk of encountering the Lord. May our journeys too, lead us to a more profound encounter with God, an encounter that restores our hope, deepens our faith, and strengthens our commitment to the Lord.

# Reading the Scriptures

In today's Gospel reading two disciples were walking together and thinking sadly about how Jesus had just been tortured and killed. Then Jesus started walking with them- but they didn't recognize Him. He explained to them what the Scriptures had said about Him suffering and dying. He helped them to understand what God's plan had been.



Every time we go to Mass we hear about Jesus in the Gospel reading. But we don't need to wait until Mass to learn about Jesus. You can read the Bible every day. God wants us to know Him better so we can love Him more. And the more we love Him the happier we will be.

Do you have a children's Bible? Maybe your Mom or Dad can read to you from the big Bible a little every morning or night. Reading saint stories also helps us to know God through His friends. Try to read or listen to some of the Bible or the life of a saint every day!
