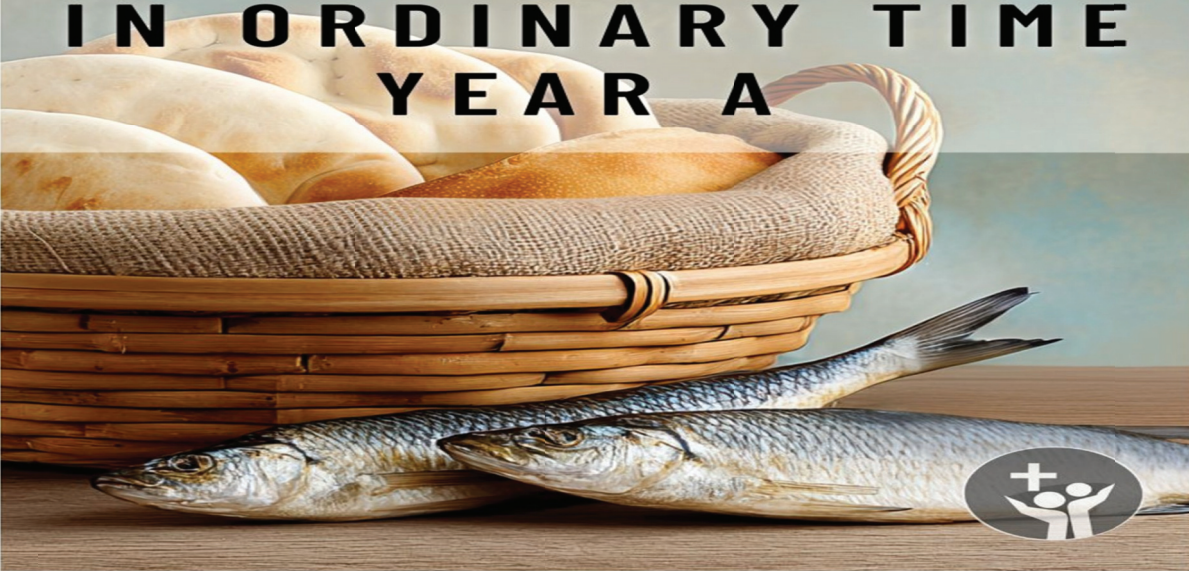

The Power of Five Loaves and Two Fish

When Jesus told his disciples to feed the crowd, all they could see was the negative. Five loaves and two fish. What good would that do for so many mouths to feed?

Our Gospel story teaches us how to respond to people who might need our help. Do we only see the negative? There are so many of them. What good can I do? The task is too big for me. And like the disciples, we choose the easy way. We look away, pretending not to hear the cries for help; and hoping that others can help them.

But today, Jesus teaches us that five loaves and two fish is enough. God will provide what is lacking. It has been said that when the crowd saw the disciples giving out the loaves and fish, they took out also what they brought and shared them with others. All it takes is for one person to act, others will follow.

In the Philippines, at the height of Covid Pandemic, there were tables with goods, and the sign said: *"give according to your ability, take according to your need."* It started with one street, and soon enough, there were others like it. All it takes is one willing to share. God, working through the power of love, takes care of the rest.

Jesus Feeds Five Thousand

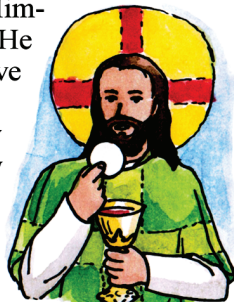
with five loaves and two fish



In today's Gospel reading, the disciples see all the hungry people who had come to listen to Our Lord and to be healed. They know that they can't feed them all, so they ask Jesus to send them to the towns to buy food. But Jesus isn't limited by nature, because He is God. He blesses a bit of bread and fish and it becomes enough to feed over five thousand people!

Our Lord was showing us that He will provide for all our needs if we listen to Him, just like it says in today's reading from the prophet Isaiah. In this story He was providing for the people's bodily needs, but He also provides for our spiritual needs.

In Holy Communion, Jesus gives Himself to us for spiritual food. Just like He could do the miracle of feeding the five thousand, He works the miracle of turning bread and wine into His Body and Blood for us at every Mass. Now He feeds millions of people all over the world with Himself!

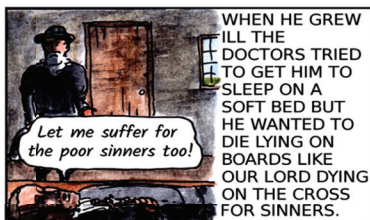
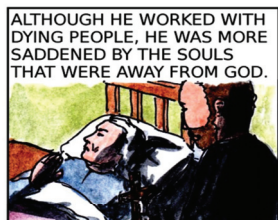
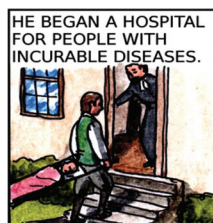
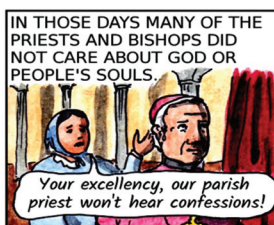


In today's Gospel reading, Jesus turns five loaves and two fish into enough food for over 5000 people! On top of all that, they collected baskets full of leftovers.

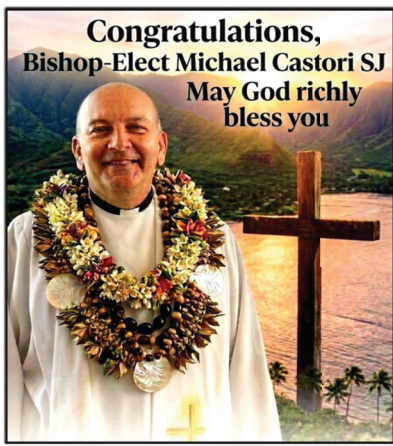

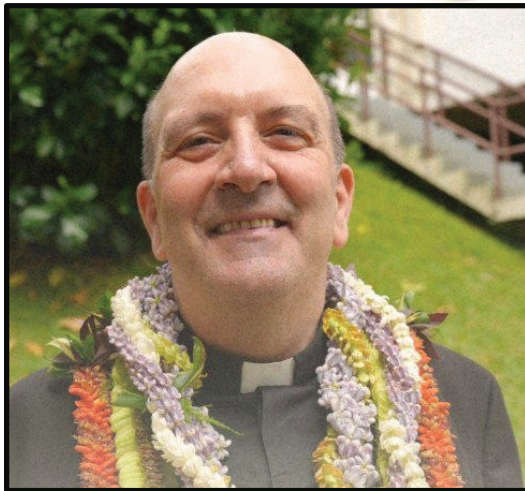
The Transfiguration

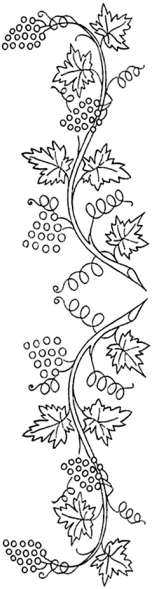
