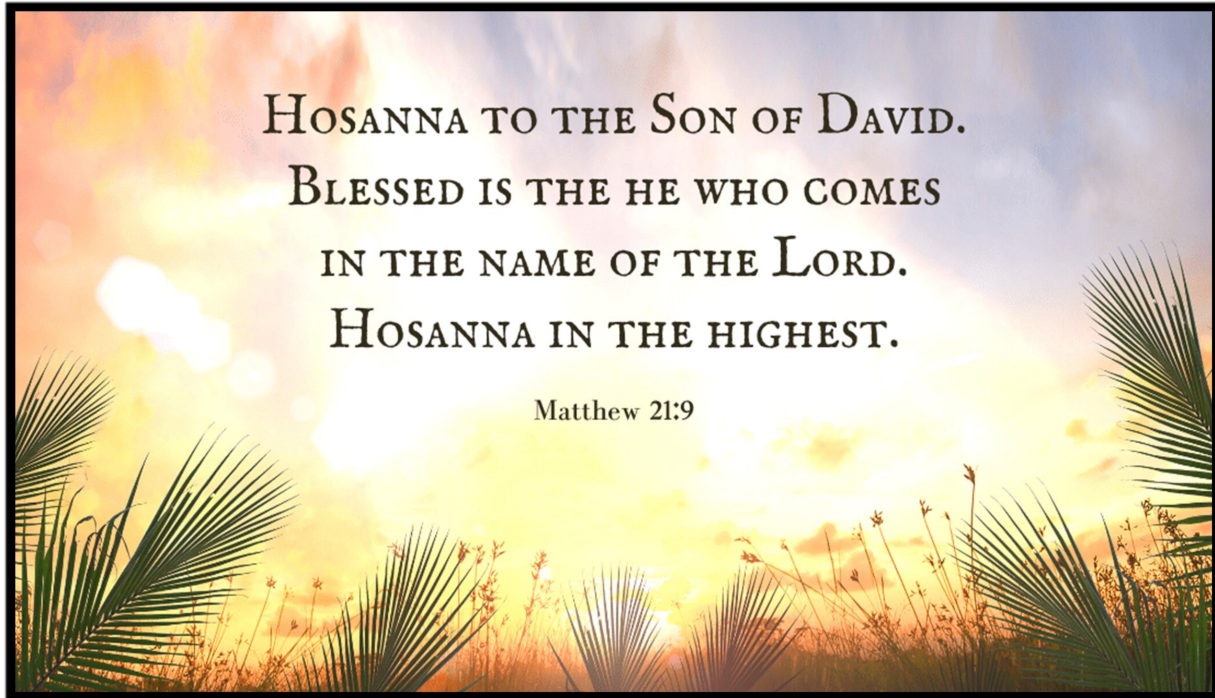

The Palms and The Passion

Today ends the 40 days of lent and we enter the Holy Week. Also, we commemorate the triumphant entry of Jesus into the city of Jerusalem (symbolized by the palms), but it also marks the formal start of his passion.

When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the people cheered and greeted him as they waved their palm branches. He was greeted as a victorious King. This Sunday, as the Church invites us to lift our palms and echo the joyful cries of *Hosanna*, may we also lift our hearts to Christ. Let our palms remind us of our need for a Saviour and inspire us to journey through Holy Week with deeper faith, hope, and a desire to live a life triumphant in him.

But let us not forget that this celebration is not only about the palms, but also about the passion and death of Jesus. That is why the gospel read to us is an account on Jesus' passion. We are called to reflect and accompany Jesus in his passion. As we begin the Holy Week, let us reflect on one very important truth: **Jesus died for us. He died for each and everyone of us...**because he loved us so much.

Holy Week

Did you know that this week is the most important one in the whole year? Holy Week has Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. On these days we remember and celebrate the most important things that Jesus did before His resurrection on Easter Sunday.

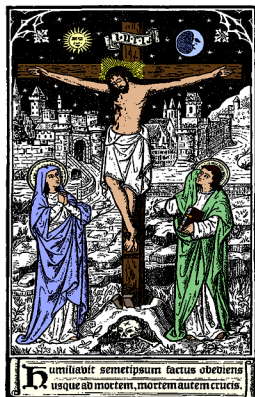
On Holy Thursday Jesus said the first Mass and made his apostles the first priests. Go to Mass on Thursday if you can, and think about what Jesus did- He made bread and wine into Himself so that He could still be with us after He went back into Heaven.

On Good Friday Jesus suffered terribly and then died on the cross because of our sins. He offered up His life, even though He had never sinned, so that all of us could go to Heaven. That's why we call it "Good" Friday. Can you offer some sacrifice to Jesus in return for what He did for you?

On Holy Saturday Jesus' body was in the tomb. His friends were all shocked by what had happened and were afraid and sad. They did not remember what was going to happen next... Do you remember what happened after Holy Saturday?

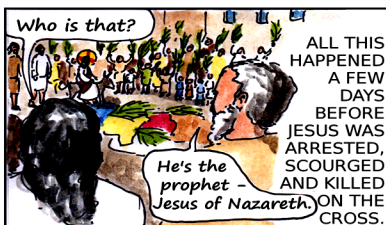
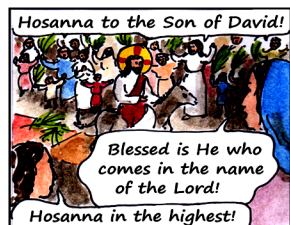

What did Jesus do on the cross?

On Good Friday JESUS was taken before King HEROD and the governor, PILATE. Even though He had not committed any crime He was scourged and condemned to die on the CROSS. He CARRIED the cross as far as He could up CALVARY hill, but when He got too weak a man named SIMON of CYRENE was forced to help Him. On the way He met His mother, MARY, who WEPT at seeing her Son in such pain. A woman named VERONICA wiped the blood and sweat from His face with a cloth. At the top of the HILL Jesus was thrown onto the cross and His HANDS and FEET were fastened to it with NAILS. They raised the cross, where Jesus hung for three hours before He DIED. He did all this to SAVE us from Hell. At the cross were JOHN, Mary MAGDALENE, His mother, and some other women. At the moment He died the curtain of the old Temple was TORN in half. When His body was taken down from the cross JOSEPH of Arimathea and NICODEMUS BURIED Him in a new TOMB and rolled a HEAVY STONE in front of the door.
