Important Information: The goods and services shown are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must purchase any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing in the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Services in Other States: While we are honored to coordinate out-of-state paperwork, removals, and burials, not all states reciprocate with Missouri. Therefore, when death occurs out-of-state OR any portion of the arrangements are to be conducted out of state, additional fees may apply. Costs will vary depending on the type of arrangements you choose. The prices contained herein represent arrangements within 50 miles IN MISSOURI.

Payment for at-need funeral services will be discussed during the arrangement conference. Payment by in-force, non-contestable life insurance with verifiable beneficiaries and an insurance assignment may be acceptable and will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. We try very hard to assist with privately purchased insurance, and it takes a lot of time. Therefore, a minimum fee of \$200 per insurance company is assessed when we assist in filing claims. A few companies offer claims by phone when they have successfully confirmed certain information and the policy beneficiary is available to authorize payment to the funeral home. In such cases, the \$200 fee is waived. A 3% processing fee is assessed when payment is rendered by a credit card. When paying for any arrangement with life insurance, cash advance items and sales tax are due on the day of arrangements. When circumstances warrant an autopsy, the death certificate will be substantially delayed, often 90 to 120 days. This also delays insurance settlements, so additional fees may be assessed.

Interest at the rate of 1.5% per month (18 % per annum) Will be assessed the 30th day following a death.

So we may provide our best service to you, Appointments for Funeral/Cremation Conferences, Prearrangements, Finalizing Insurance Transactions, Releasing of Cremated Remains, Keepsakes, and Death Certificates, must Be Scheduled in advance between the hours of 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., Monday through Friday. Please understand our buildings may sometimes be locked because we are conducting services off premises.

Our staff is available by telephone 24 hours a day. However, unless services have been previously scheduled, our facilities will be closed on the days of New Year's; Good Friday, Saturday, and Easter; Memorial; Independence; Labor; Veterans; Thanksgiving and Thanksgiving Friday, Christmas Eve, and Christmas Day. This means staff will not be in the building, but staff is always available by telephone. Please call-in advance to ensure a staff member is available.

Prices of caskets available in selection rooms range from \$1695 to \$6995. Prices of outer burial containers range from \$1995 to \$2895. Based on personal preference or need, other caskets and outer containers are available to order.

Embalming will be evaluated and addressed on a case-by-case basis when a decedent is afflicted with contagious disorders, including but not limited to Ebola, Anthrax, or Creutzfeldt-Jakob Diseases. These types of afflictions pose dangers to our staff. We are currently able to embalm Covid-19 descendants without charging this fee; however, we reserve the right to impose this fee if cases in our area increase. Coronaviruses are a group of related RNA viruses. They cause respiratory tract infections that can range from mild to lethal. More lethal varieties can cause SARS, MERS, and Covid-19. These contagious circumstances require the use of multiple sets of personal protective equipment, the use of specialized disinfecting products for employees, rooms, vehicles, and equipment exposed to the virus. Other precautions may be necessary, such as postponing arrangement conferences, visitations, services, and burials. Therefore, when our staff is considered to be at increased risk, a \$350 fee will apply.

Various Cremation Arrangements, Direct Cremation and Body Donation (for weight exceeding 300 pounds, see chart below for applicable fees)

***CREMATION** is the process of reducing the body to basic chemical compounds (such as dry calcium phosphate) by heat and oxidation at high temperatures. A rigid cardboard container is required for the cremation process. When provided by the funeral home, the dimensions of the cremation container are 24" x 74 3/4" x 13 1/4".
