The St. Joseph school board met Tuesday, September 2 at 6pm in the Parish Hall.

Fr. Jake shared that he visited our 7th graders, affirming how science, history and faith are woven together, referencing the book of Genesis. Too, noted his plans to visit the 4th grade classrooms later in the week.

A summary of the diocesan mission and curriculum days for our staff was offered. Reports were given regarding the upkeep of technology in the classroom alongside plans to reinforce our Catholic identity with the continuation of the Strength=Virtue program, holy cards for the upcoming new saints (Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati!!), and plans to celebrate the Jubilee Year that was proclaimed by Pope Francis. The board was also informed of our new Theology of the Body curriculum for our K-5 students thanks to a donation provided by our Knights of Columbus. Our student athletes' success on the volleyball courts was noted. Much discussions also went into school safety planning and improving as well as outlining the sound proactive measures already in place.
