ART is a breakthrough, drug-free therapy that allows individuals to release the emotional pain of traumatic or distressing memories while keeping the facts intact. Using visualization techniques and rapid eye movements similar to those experienced during dreaming, ART helps reprogram the way troubling images and memories are stored in the brain.

Participants will learn how ART can be used to resolve feelings of anxiety, depression, grief, trauma, and other emotional challenges. The therapy is unique in that it does not require clients to share specific details of their experiences. Instead, the process focuses on reducing the emotional and physical reactions that often accompany difficult memories, allowing individuals to rewrite their story and move forward with renewed clarity and hope. The results can often bring immediate improvement.

We met our first goal! Albendazole for a year!

Thank you to all who donated to the Dominican Republic project. Our first goal was to fund a year supply of Albendazole. This medication inhibits the growth of parasitic worms in the gastrointestinal tracts. In low-income countries, parasitic worms can be acquired by a variety of routes such as contaminated food, water, and soil. Once acquired the worms interfere with nutrient absorption and can cause malnourishment of the affected individual. Thank you for your support!
