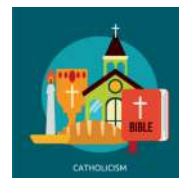

DISMISSAL PROCEDURE

NEW!

The Monroe Street Entrance will be opened at 2:00 pm for student pick up. The 5th Street gate will remain closed until cars are dismissed from the lot.

Pull into to the parking lot and follow the north fencing to the west side of the lot. Pull forward to the painted line, or up to the car in front of you (don't leave extra space). If you cannot fit within the painted lines, you must start a new row.

We will fill the lot from west to east (fence to building). Space between the last car and the north fence is reserved as a gather space for parents to wait for students as they exit the building. **Don't park crooked or along the north fence.**

No vehicles are permitted to park on 5th Street (unless the lot is full). If the lot is full, you may park on the east side of 5th St. You should wait in your car for the lot to empty before pulling in. Once the lot is empty, you may enter to pick up your child(ren).

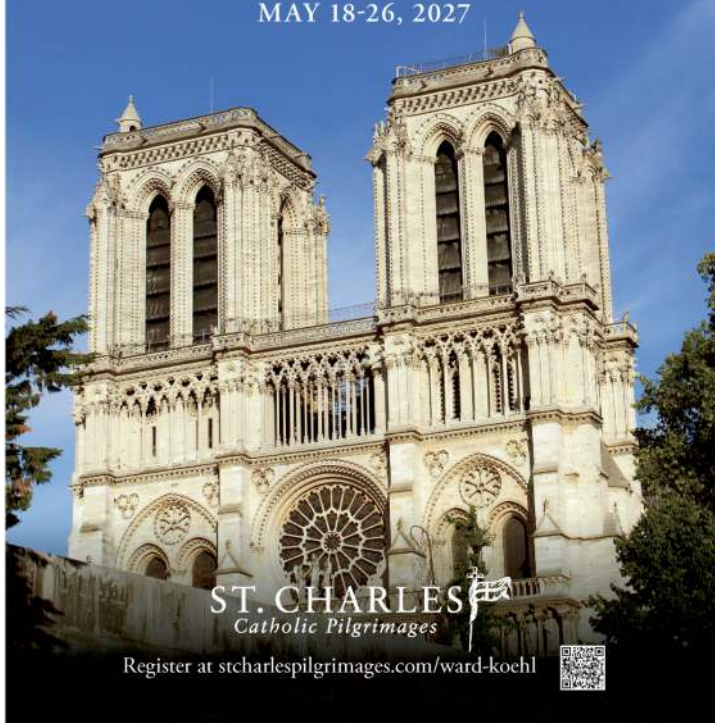

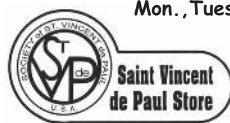
