Good morning,

In this early morning hour, I will try to have a silent visit with y'all. Everything is quiet except the crickets, which remind me that fall is just around the corner. Often, when I hear the crickets sing, it brings me back to the days when we used to look forward to going with Dad to the Reninger's Auction and coming home with watermelons for the family. They came all the way from Florida, although that only happened a few times a year.

Busy canning season is here. This week we had a corn day—whoever needed some corn for their freezer came and helped until everything was done. The fruit trees are just loaded again this year. Next week we'll do the same with apples for applesauce. Yesterday, Harvey and Wilson's two boys picked approximately 25 bushels of apples off of only two trees, all for sauce. Next week we'll make enough applesauce for whatever each family needs, then we'll give the rest to someone else. The late apples will probably go for cider later in the fall. The best cider is made using apples after a few hard frosts, and also a variety of them. Our old faithful pear tree doesn't look like it could hold one more pear. Now I hope someone needs pears to can. The grape arbor is also loaded with nice clusters of grapes.

Tonight we are getting company for overnight and breakfast. Our four bedrooms will be occupied. They are traveling through this area and needed an overnight stay, so I will make a breakfast egg casserole and stick it in the fridge, then bake it in the morning for an easy breakfast. I think I will close for now, because it is starting to get daylight and I usually like to do my flowers early. Every day I try to have fresh-cut flower bouquets at the store. I often think of the song, "I come to the garden alone, while the dew is still on the roses." It is more relaxing in the garden if I can beat the warm sun. But with these cool nights and warm days, the flowers are bringing out their brilliant colors. Harvey usually says that also brings color to the apples, translocates the sugar, and makes the fruit sweeter.

Harvey was busy getting more pasture land ready. It's basically ready for seeding, and he hopes to put cattle in there yet this fall. Last week a nephew, his boys, and a few of his workers did the fencing. Next, they want to build a shelter for the cattle so that when bad weather hits, they have some protection. Harvey really enjoys this type of work—taking land that has been wilderness for years and putting it back into production. The few neighbors who border the property are so thankful that it is getting cleared. Some of them still remember when this 50 acres was farmed and then saw it go back into wilderness. Thanks to our neighbor, Nathan Nolt, who last summer worked for weeks—maybe

months—cleaning and pushing brush, and is now burning all the trash. A local guy is cutting all the firewood for him and also enough for us for our winter supply.

School bells will soon be ringing. How exciting—that means a new pair of shoes and usually a new bonnet or a new lunch box. If we were lucky enough, my sister and I got a new dress, and sometimes the bonnet was made out of the leftover dress fabric. But we had older sisters, so oftentimes we got hand-me-down dresses. Then, when I was in sixth grade, I sewed my own dresses. My very first dress—I just could not get the sleeve to fit. Finally, I decided to go for help. My older sister said, "Look, you are trying to fit the sleeve into where the neck should be."

Beatrice, the schoolteacher, will soon be back. She lives in the other end of our house and teaches special needs children. This is the fifth term that she is here just through the school year. Her home is in Pennsylvania, where she lives with her parents during summer vacation. I talked with her yesterday and she said she is looking forward to another school term, and I was glad to hear that. It is just wonderful we have people who understand those children's hearts.

I will close, because it is just getting daylight and it is time for a walk in the garden.

If we fill our hearts with regrets of yesterday and worries of tomorrow, we have no today in which to be thankful.

Apple Cake

INGREDIENTS:

4 cups diced peeled apples

2 cups sugar

2 eggs

2 cups flour

3 tsp. cinnamon

o top. ciriran

2 tsp. soda

1 cup chopped nuts

1 cup sugar

1 cup brown sugar

1/4 cup flour

2 cups water

1/2 cup butter or margarine

2 tsp. vanilla

INSTRUCTIONS:

Mix apples and sugar, set aside until sugar dissolves. Add eggs, beat well. Mix and add flour, cinnamon and soda. Add nuts. Pour into a greased 13x9 pan. Bake at 375° for 40 minutes. This can be cut in half for an 8x8 pan. Bring last six ingredients to a boil, cook and stir until thickened. Serve sauce with cake.



Savory Power Mix

INGREDIENTS:

Total of 4 qts (16cups) mix/match to your liking : pumpkin seeds, sunflower seeds, walnuts or pecans, cashews

1 1/2 cup butter or coconut oil

3 Tbs smoked Paprika

3 Tbs Onion Powder

2 Tbs Garlic Powder 1/2 cup Nutritional yeast 1/2-3/4 cup Coconut aminos (This is where you get the saltiness AND nutrition) 1/2 cup Franks Hot Sauce (slightly on the spicy side, adjust to suit your taste)

INSTRUCTIONS:

Melt butter/coconut oil, and add seasoning and amino acids. Stir well to combine.

Pout Butter mixture over seed/nut mixture.

Stir gently to coat.

Bake 80-90 minutes at 250° stirring every 20 minutes.

Once done, pour out onto paper

towels to cool, then enjoy!

Notes: I was looking for high protein snack, with B vitamins (hence the nutritional yeast) and healthy fats (coconut oil) and amino acids.
