We engage with those whose voices are often misrepresented or unheard – refugees, migrants and religious minorities, those facing mental health challenges, for example – and enable individuals and organisations who might not otherwise meet to communicate, connect and better understand once another through participating in artistic projects and programmes.

Our projects offer opportunities to develop skills in communication, creative practice, empathy and leadership. They result in artistic productions that reach broad audiences and stimulate new ways of seeing and listening. 

WE ASKED: HOW HAS BEING INVOLVED WITH TOGETHER PRODUCTIONS AFFECTED YOU?

"I have felt like I am making a small contribution to society in the projects the Mixed Up Chorus has been involved in. Singing with a purpose in such a friendly choir has given me a sense of being part of a worthwhile community. It has given me a chance to volunteer in various ways in the past. Have loved being creative in ways that I wouldn't normally as part of the writing new songs for Singing Our Lives. Performing at concerts has been a challenge and given me confidence".

GROWTH & CONSOLIDATION

We were delighted to expand the Together Productions family this year and appoint a new part-time Head of Programmes, Programmes Producer, Digital Content Producer and Engagement and Pathways Coordinator. We continued to work closely with our teams of volunteers and steering committees across all projects.

We developed new partnerships with the Red Cross in Hackney & Thurrock and the Manor Gardens centre, Islington.

"They are utterly committed to their mission, to community involvement and diversity as well as positive social change. I appreciate that very, very much and it inspires me".

We built on our relationship with the Mind and Soul Choir at the Maudsley Hospital to co-create a new programme of work exploring the links between singing, leadership and mental health - *Singing For Our Minds* - successfully securing funding from the Baring Foundation.

We reviewed and updated policies, procedures and infrastructure.

We completed the **Measuring the Good** programme, undertaking a wideranging consultation with participants, stakeholders, participants, audiences and the wider public and developing evaluatio and imapact methologies for all programmes.

We held a **Together Productions Vision Day** with staff, participants and stakeholders and redesigned our Vision, Mission and Theory of Change.



STABILITY & DIVERSIFICATION

Despite the challenges of the ongoing pandemic and lockdown, through the continued development and innovation of our online offer we were able to retain membership of our choirs. Subscriptions saw a slight downturn due to the constrained financial circumstances of many participants but the income stream remained steady.

We continued to attract support particularly for the Sing for Freedom Choir, receiving donations including £1069 from Linklaters in September 2020 and raising £10, 359 (129% target) in an Indiegogo Crowdfunding Campaign in January 2021.

We were successful in applications for grants from:

The School For Social Entrepreneurs - £5000 December 20 Culture Recovery Fund - £34, 800 March 2021 Comic Relief Community Fund - £3920 March 2021 The Baring Foundation - £39, 974 July 2021

These allowed us to maintain our online offer to our community and retain our staff team, deliver new projects and develop a new strand of work - leadership training for artists from diverse backgrounds in singing and mental health.
