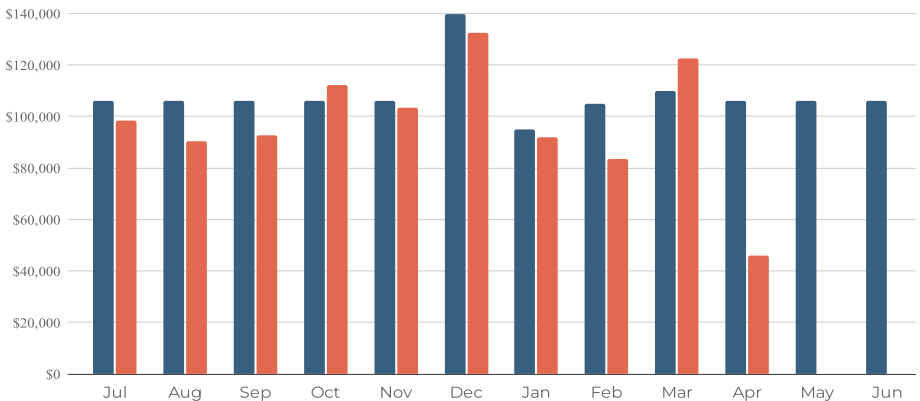


IMPACT PARTNER OF THE MONTH
