Student Conduct Agreement and Discipline Policy

This must be reviewed with EACH registered child.
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Students enrolled in the Mary of Nazareth School Extended Care Program are expected to exhibit respect for authority and for one another, self-discipline, obedience to school policies and regulations, and teachings of the Catholic faith.

I hereby agree that as a participant in the Mary of Nazareth Extended Care Program, my child is required to exhibit appropriate and acceptable behavior at all times. I am aware that poor or inappropriate behavior, such as refusing to follow directions, unacceptable language, fighting and back-talking to extended care staff, will not be tolerated and may result in my being asked to remove my child from the program. I am also aware that there is zero tolerance for verbal abuse and/or physical abuse from parents as well as students. Parents will be notified if warnings should occur. After **two warnings**, the Principal will be notified and a parent conference will be scheduled. If the problem persists, the child will be asked to leave the Extended Care Program.

Be Advised: Parents will be subject to charges for any damage or breakage to the School property or the Katie Fitzgerald Center if caused by their child. The parent will be informed promptly of the incident. The child will be reconsidered for attendance in the Extended Care Program after payment has been received.
