Registration for Capitol Manners five session Cotillion finishing program ("Cotillion") is limited to enrolled students through Mary of Nazareth registration process. **Payments are non-refundable.**

**Attendance at Cotillion is a privilege.** We do not have the parent volunteer workforce to tolerate inappropriate behaviors, conduct or disciplinary issues. Registration of your child for Cotillion requires that you read and review the behavioral contract below with your child.

The Parents accept full responsibility for their child's observance of all rules and are responsible for any damage caused directly or indirectly by their child to the venue, any service provider, and/or any attendee or chaperone at the event.

Any student or parent who engages in inappropriate behavior, as determined by the Capitol Manners staff or Mary of Nazareth chaperones will be given a warning on the **first offense**, asked to leave the class at the **second offense** immediately, and if there is a third **infraction** the student's or parent's participation will be terminated with no refund.

Students with **inappropriate attire will not be admitted** and must be picked up by the Parent.

Parents or a designated guardian are required to register their student at the check-in table upon arrival and check out the student. **Students will not be able to have their electronic devices during sessions.** Capitol Manners is not responsible for any damage or loss to any personal items.

Parents may be asked to volunteer as parent chaperones. Parent chaperone duties include ensuring general good behavior of students, greeting, arrival and departure of students.

Registration is on a first come first serve basis. **In the event of a severe gender imbalance in enrollment, Capitol Manners reserves the right to remove registration (with full refund) via lottery.** (This is an exceedingly rare event, and we will make every effort to avoid this outcome.)

In consideration of an offer to register or otherwise participate in an event sponsored by Capitol Manners, LLC, and Mary of Nazareth (collectively "Sponsors") each Student and Parent (collectively "Participants") agrees, for themselves and for and on behalf of their minors, to indemnify, waive, release (the "Indemnity") and hold Sponsors harmless from any and all damages, liabilities, causes of action, claims, and losses and related expenses whatsoever arising from or relating to Sponsors or the Cotillion courses including as a result of the negligence of Sponsors; provided that such indemnity shall not be available to Sponsors to the extent that such damages, liabilities, causes of action, claims, and losses and related expenses are determined by a court of competent jurisdiction by final and non-appealable judgment to have resulted from the gross negligence or willful misconduct of Sponsors. Participants further agree to indemnify Sponsors regarding any losses, damages, claims, or causes of action directly or indirectly relating to their, or their minor's, participation in Sponsors including, but not limited to, the Cotillion courses, and any activities prior to and after the Cotillion final graduation dinner. Participation in the Cotillion is voluntary, and Participants assume all risk associated therewith. Sponsors are not responsible for the safety or conduct of Participants.
