

Capitol Manners Mary of Nazareth Cotillion Student Behavior Contract



I agree with the following code of conduct:

I will **maintain** a Christ-like behavior and **decorum** at all activities.

I will be respectful to all Cotillion staff, chaperones, and fellow students. I will not use any profane language.

I understand that there is **no talking during the class** whenever the instructor is speaking. I understand as a student I must engage fully in all activities, must **speak when spoken to**, engage in exercises when selected, volunteer as needed and roll play when asked.

I will adhere to the dress code.

- Dress Code for Boys: dress pants, dress shirt, and tie are required; blazers are encouraged. Shirt must be tucked into pants. No jeans. No sneakers.
- Dress Code for Girls: dress or skirt with blouse. White gloves. No pants. No sneakers.

I understand I should arrive to each session 10-15 minutes early. I understand, my parents must sign me out each night. I will check-in my electronic devices before each session. I understand participating in Cotillion means I will be dancing. I will adhere to the rules of social dance. All students are required physically to touch their partners as instructed. All students are required to rotate partners. Students may not break in and out of line to "avoid" specific partners as this is considered rude behavior.

Dance education sometimes requires hands-on instruction as well as verbal instruction. **I understand instructors may correct dancers** by touching their arms, hands, back, and head to move them in correct positions. I acknowledge that this is common in dance instruction. I understand that it is the student's responsibility to communicate clearly with the teacher and/or the director if any form of touch is unacceptable.

For **any violations of the above rules** and for any behavior judged as inappropriate by parent chaperone volunteers in attendance:

- First infraction will be a warning to the student;
- Second infraction the student will be asked to leave the class for the evening; their parents will be phoned to pick them up;
- Third infraction and the student will be expelled from further attendance at Capitol Manners Cotillion with no refund.

I agree with the above rules of dress, conduct and behavior for Capitol Manners Cotillion at Mary of Nazareth. I understand that repeated behavioral violations will lead to expulsion from the class with no refund.
