Please read the following directions regarding the Math IXL Chart.

1. Sign in using your Mary of Nazareth login and password <https://www.ixl.com/signin>
2. Must complete all 10 IXL Standards.
3. Must earn 100% on each standard
4. A completed IXL chart signed by one parent needs to be turned in to your math teacher during the first week of school, not your homeroom teacher.
5. Completed standards with a mastery of 100% for each will result in two first quarter quiz grades.
 - a. The first five skills will account for the first quiz grade and the second five skills will account for the second quiz grade.
6. Please note that when logging in each time you should double check that you are using the correct skill name and grade level from the list below. (Websites get periodically updated, so be sure to rely first and foremost on the skill name.)

Reading

1. Select **two books**:
 - One nonfiction book (such as a biography)
 - o One chapter book of your choice
2. For each book, complete one of the recommendation forms found in the reading packet.
3. Book Log: Keep track of all summer reading using the Book Log included in the reading packet.
4. Reading Packet: Complete 1–2 pages each week. The packet contains engaging activities that review spelling, grammar, and other language arts skills.
