Throughout the nearly four decades that Corbett Funeral Home has been serving the families in and around Cambridge Ontario, we been guided by a simple principle: “We Care”. To this day, we proudly continue to pursue that same ideal. Early in their tenure, Corbett and Makcrow would hire a young funeral director named Steve Parker who would become a mainstay of the firm and who after 18 years of service would be the obvious choice to take up the torch following the departure of the founders. For Steve Parker a personal dream was realized on January 31 of 2006 when he assumed ownership of Corbett Funeral Home.

Steve’s career at Corbett’s – including 20 years as the owner – would see him put his own mark on the business, establishing a personal and professional relationship with his community grounded in trust and reliability. Assembling a respected team of professionals, he modernized the business, and, on July 30, 2015, expanded the firm with the acquisition of the Lounsbury Funeral Home in Hespeler, Cambridge.

In February 2026 Steve Parker retired but only after bestowing a new generation of local ownership with the same opportunity he has been given; selling his interest in the business to those he had mentored. Kevin Medeiros and Sarah Mazmanian, both licensed funeral directors who had been with Corbett’s for several years, became the new owner-managers of the firm.

Today, with pride in our legacy of service and local ownership, the team at Corbett and Lounsbury Funeral Homes continue to offer the families of Cambridge a full range of services from the most traditional to the unique and highly personalized. The removal of a pacemaker or implant may be carried out by a licensed medical professional. Normally this will be included in our embalming charges but we do reserve the right in some circumstances and by recommendation by the coroner to have the device removed professionally. In those cases there will be a charge but will be discussed fully prior to this.

Professional restorative procedures \$ \$75.00 per hour
In some circumstances, additional restorative efforts beyond those captured in the standard embalming procedure are necessary to enhance the appearance of the deceased. In such cases, the funeral director will discuss the available options and their cost. Professional restorative procedures will be charged at \$75.00 per hour.

Video Tribute production \$ 150.00
Video Tribute Pricing & Guidelines. The cost to produce a Video Tribute is \$150.00, which includes one USB copy of the completed video. Additional USB copies are available for \$15.00 each. The Video Tribute includes up to 125 photographs. 125 photographs is both the recommended and maximum number. Photographs must be provided at least 24 hours in advance to allow sufficient time for staff and equipment preparation. A \$50.00 surcharge applies if a USB format is requested and the video exceeds 125 photographs. The use of an LCD monitors to display the memorial video is included in the purchase of a Video Tribute, as it is required for proper display. Technical support for Video Tributes not produced by the Funeral Home is \$75.00. This applies if a family-made video requires editing, reformatting, or modification for compatibility.

Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.

Bereavement Authority of Ontario Consumer Protection Fee \$30.00 (As of July 1, 2023)

Coroner's fee – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario, and is currently \$75.

Clergy honorarium – this is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In most cases the amount is set by the clergy or the church involved.

Newspaper or radio notices – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or radio or other media outlets.

Municipal death registration fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

Crematorium - This is a fee paid to the crematorium for the cremation of the deceased. The funeral home will co-ordinate the date and time of the cremation and the return of cremated remains to the funeral home.

Flowers – Floral Shop to be selected and arranged by family.

Payment and Funding

We are proud to offer various prepayment, funding and financing options to our clients.

Payment – At Need Services

Payment in full is due 30 days from the signing of the contract. (Due Date). Amounts outstanding after that date will bear interest at the rate of 1% per month (12.56% per annum) calculated daily and compounded monthly from the due date until paid in full. There will be a charge of \$25.00 for any non-sufficient funds (NSF) cheques returned by the bank. Any costs of collection shall be the responsibility of the Purchaser. Acceptable means of payment are cash, cheque or Visa.

If you are prepaying for services or supplies, pre-authorized chequing is also available. See below for options.

Funding

For your convenience, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

Trust: You may pay the money directly to us and we will place it in trust, where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.

Insurance: You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered or the contract is cancelled.
